1 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

Boats already registered for CYC Belmont Skyline Series are eligible and are automatically entered.

2 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

Signals made ashore will be displayed on the staff at the east end of Chicago Yacht Club, Belmont Station in coordination with signals made ashore at Chicago Corinthian Yacht Club.

3 SECTION BREAKS & FLAGS

3.1 Section Breaks:

Jam 1: PHRF \leq 150 (flag 1)

Jam 2: PHRF $>$ 150 (flag 2)

Spin 7: PHRF \geq 130 (flag 7)

Spin 6: 69 \leq PHRF \leq 129 (flag 6)

Turbo: PHRF $<$ 69 (flag 4)

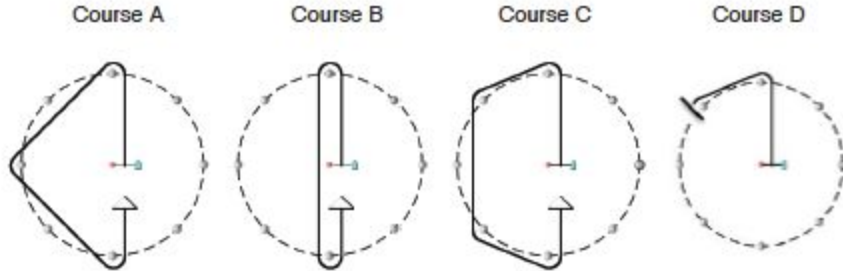

6 STARTS

- 6.1 Start with RC to starboard, orange SA1 pin to port
- 6.2 Mark 1 direction (upwind) is displayed in the window of the RC boat. The proceeding marks are based on this direction and outlined in the CCYC Course Diagrams.
- 6.3 Take all marks to port.
- 6.4 Five minute rolling starts are as follows:

*These times are published as a guideline for the racers. It may become necessary for the RC to alter or deviate from this time.

7 SCORING

This event is scored as a Belmont Skyline Series Race. The race course is combined with CCYC; the scoring is not combined.

8 POST RACING SOCIAL

CYC-Belmont Station bar and buffet will be available after racing.

9 AWARDS

Daily race awards will be presented at Belmont Station.

10 EXTRA INFORMATION

- If wind is light before racing, RC may post or announce alternate course D for all starts. This is announced on VHF 72.
- If RC wants to shorten course due to light winds or such after starts and JAM boats are racing, the course is shorted at JAM's 3rd mark and trapezoid's 4th mark with announcement on VHF 72. If no JAM boats start, course can be shortened at any point.
- Typically prepare chute after rounding windward mark, some will fly chute to 2nd mark.
- For sure spinnaker up as you round 2nd mark.



- Maybe carry spinnaker around 3rd mark to 4th mark.
- Drop chute at 4th mark and upwind to RC boat to finish (take RC to starboard, orange SA1 pin to port)
