# NOTICE OF RACE

### 1. Rules

- 1.1 These races will be governed by *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the prescriptions of the US Sailing Association, and the rules of the International Laser Class Association except as any of these are altered by this notice, and/or by the sailing instructions.
- 1.2 The fundamental rule under Part One of the Laser Class Rules shall apply.

## 2. Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1 This regatta will be a Category A event as it relates to advertising.
- 2.2 All competitors must reister, sight the waiver of liability, and pay the entry fee at <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/18675</u>. On site registration will **NOT** be available. To register on the day of the regatta, you will still need to do so on-line and pay the entry fee using a credit card.

### 3. Entry Fees

The entry fee is \$20 for registering on or before midnight **March 28**. After that the entry fee is \$30. A launch fee may be collected at the marina entrance by the Washington Sailing Marina.

### 4. Schedule

Several races may be sailed on any day at the discretion of the race committee. The warning signal for the first race on each day is scheduled as indicated below.

### 5. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be posted to the regatta website a few days before the regatta: <u>http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/18675</u>. Sailing Instructions will <u>not</u> be available at registration.

### 6. Venue & Racing Area

- 6.1 The Washington Sailing Marina is located at 1 Marina Drive, Alexandria, Virginia 22314, just off of the George Washington Parkway about 1.5 miles south of Reagan National Airport and a similar distance north of Old Town Alexandria.
- 6.2 Races will be conducted on the Potomac River east of the airport landing pier. If a change to that plan is necessary, the race committee (RC) will announce the change at the competitor's

meeting.

7. **Scoring:** If 4 or fewer races are completed, a boat's series score will be the total of all her race scores. Otherwise, her worst score will be excluded. This changes RRS A2. Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat to finish will be scored TLP (time limit penalty). TLP is two plus the number of boats finishing within the time limit, and not thereafter retiring or being disgualified. This changes rule 35, A4.1, and A4.2.

### 8. Trophies

Trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places (minimum). Deeper awards may be given.

### 9. Launching

Two ramps are available. For launching off the ramp, competitors will be required to provide their own beach dollies. Road trailers can also be used.

### 10. Sustainability

PRSA has joined the race to restore the health of our waterways in partnership with the Sailors for the Sea Clean Regattas Program. Protecting our natural resources (including National Parks such as Washington Sailing Marina) and our local waters (including the Potomac River) is very important to us. We ask for your help in this effort when racing with PRSA. In particular, we ask that you:

- Use reusable rather than single-use water bottles.
- Ensure that recycling and trash is separated properly before disposing of waste (please take note of the separate recycling bins for cans, bottles, paper, and cardboard in the dinner area; food waste should be placed in the trash).
- Print one copy of the Sailing Instructions for yourself in advance using double-sided printing if you wish to have a hard copy of the SIs.
- Consider a water only washdown for your boat following the event.

### 11. **Disclaimer of Liability**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, "Decision to Race." The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
