**1. Organizing Authority & Host**

**2. Rules**

This regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

**3. Eligibility & Entry**

**3.1** The regatta is open to all boats of the Optimist class (including wood, plastic and fiberglass hulls), Collegiate 420 (ie No spinnaker or trapeze.) and Open BIC. They will race and be scored in 4 classes; the Optimist Gold class will consist of Optimist sailors with 1.5 years or more of sailing experience, all other Optimist sailors will sail in the Silver class, a 420 class and an Open BIC class.

**4.1** All competitors must check in on Sunday, April 28, 2019 between the hours of 10:00 and 11:00 a.m.

## **6. Sailing Instructions**

## **7. Courses**

Courses will consist of triangles for Optimist and Open Bic, Windward Leeward for 420's. A 3-minute sound sequence will be used for the start.

## **8. Scoring**

One race constitutes a regatta.

## **9. Prizes**

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 finishers in each class

## **10. Snacks during racing**

Coaches and families are encouraged to bring their own snacks and water during sailing.

## **11. Safety**

All competitors shall wear U.S. Coast Guard approved life jackets at all times while on the water.

## **12. Directions to Jaycee Park**

From US1 in Fort Pierce, take Seaway Drive across the intercoastal bridge to Hutchinson Island. Turn right onto Ocean Drive. You will see "Kimberly Bergalis Memorial Park" on the left and Jaycee Park will be on the right. Turn right on Malaleuca Dr. and go to the end. Parking is in this area on the right. The boat house is located on the water, north of the parking area.
