NOTICE OF RACE

Organizing Authority: The Corinthian Yacht Club of San Francisco (CYC), Tiburon, California

1 RULES

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except for brief periods while changing or adjusting clothing. Flag Y will not be displayed.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all boats. Boats shall register in one of the following divisions; Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Classic Yacht (by invitation only). One-Design classes may be broken out of these groups.
- 2.2 Spinnaker Division includes boats designed and rated with spinnakers and intending to sail with spinnakers during this race. The Spinnaker Division includes the Wyliecat, Star, Alerion Express, and Knarr classes and any boat designed and rated without spinnakers.
- 2.3 Non-Spinnaker Division includes boats whose PHRF rating is with spinnakers, but choose to race without spinnakers (and not expressly listed as “Spinnaker Division” above) during this race. All boats in the Non-Spinnaker divisions are subject to ratings modification by the Race Committee.
- 2.4 For Classic Yachts or any other entry without a current NCPHRF certificate, the race committee will assign a NCPHRF-comparable rating. Assigned ratings will not be grounds for redress.
- 2.5 Final division/class assignments for racing on Sunday, October 20 will be posted on the CYC official notice board and Club race website, <https://www.cyc.org>, by 1700 hours on Thursday, October 17.

3 FEES The entry fee of \$125 will be donated to the Greater Bay Area Chapter of The Leukemia & Lymphoma Society. After 1700 hours on Monday, October 14, the entry fee will be \$175..

4 SCHEDULE OF RACES Racing will take place Sunday, October 20, with the first warning scheduled for 12:00.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS Sailing instructions will be available by 1700 hours on Friday, October 18 at the CYC Clubhouse and at <https://www.cyc.org/>

6 RACING AREA AND COURSES Racing will take place in the Central Bay. Starts and finishes are expected to be around Point Knox.

7 SCORING Scoring will be done using Time-on-Time based on NCPHRF or assigned ratings.

8 COMMUNICATIONS The race committee may use VHF to communicate information about the races. The race committee may attempt to hail over early boats on VHF. The audibility, order, failure, or absence of a hail shall not be a ground for redress.

9 AWARDS Prizes will be awarded at Corinthian Yacht Club following racing.

10 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
