# **NOTICE OF RACE**

## 1. RULES

- **1.1** The Organizing Authority for this regatta is Privateer Sailing Education Foundation located at the Privateer Yacht Club (PYC).
- **1.2** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Measurement requirements do not apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- **2.1** Applicants for all classes must be rising high school seniors or younger at the start of the regatta.
- 2.2 Competitors are required to supply their own boats. (PYC may have up to 5-10 club Optis available for green fleet)
- 2.3 CLASSES \* International Optimist Dinghy: Red, Blue, White, and Green (Green fleet will be coached by TBD)

  Laser Class-Full, Radial, 4.7

  Collegiate 420 (no spinnaker or trapeze)

  BIC

  \*a class must have at least 3 entries to be officially scored.

#### 3. FEES

- **3.1 ENTRY FEES FOR EACH CLASS:** \$65.00-single hand includes racing fee and meals for skippers. \$90.00-double hand includes racing fee and meals for skipper and crew.
- **3.2 ADDITIONAL MEALS:** \$25.00 for extra meal package (includes Saturday lunch & dinner, Sunday breakfast & lunch), \$12.00 for extra dinner, \$6.00 for extra lunch or breakfast

#### 3.3 REGISTRATION

Deadline for Registration is September 15th, 2019 Late fee of \$10.00 will apply after the registration deadline Register at Regatta Network: (LINK)

#### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration.

#### 5. SCORING

- **5.1** The Low-Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 of the RRS shall apply.
  - **5.2** As many races as possible will be sailed. At least one race must be completed to constitute a Series. If seven or more races are sailed, a boat's worst score will be discarded.

#### 6. LIFEJACKETS

- **6.1** All competitors shall wear, while on the water, a U.S. Coast Guard approved PFD, except for brief periods while removing or adding clothing.
- **6.2** Each competitor shall have a whistle attached to their PFD at all times while on the water.
