Multihull A class - round Mark "F" (R "4")" and Mark "B" (G "7") to port. round Mark "N" (Craighill Light), Mark "M" (Pooles Island Light), and "D" (G1UC) to starboard, to Finish

(35.6 nautical miles).

All other classes - round Mark "F" (R "4")", Mark "B" (G "7"), and Mark "N" (Craighill Channel Light) to port, round "D" (G1UC) to starboard and head for the finish. (25.08 nm).

Finish: Same as start unless the course is shortened. Yachts are requested to identify

themselves when finishing by shining a light upon their sail numbers.

Scoring: PHRF classes will be scored using PHRF of the Chesapeake RL ratings.
