

June 9, 2019 Race 5 – Eagle Rock to Marina del Rey Sailing Instructions

1 RULES

- 1.1 This Series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- **1.2** Before the first warning, all entries shall pass by the Race Committee (R/C) boat and check in.
- 2 SCHEDULE, CLASSES AND CLASS FLAGS
- 2.1 Class assignments and flags were posted for Race 1. Depending on the total number of entries in Cruising A, that class may be split into 2 separate starts. See Race 5 Notice to Competitors # 1, which will be posted June 7th, 2019 (this changes NOR instruction 2.4).
- 2.2 The scheduled time for the first Warning Signal is 1155, with multiple sounds made 1 minute before.
- 3 NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

Notices to Competitors will be posted by 0900 race day on the Notice Board at the DRYC Cat Harbor Facility.

- 4 COURSE AND MARKS
- **4.1** From the starting line:

ALL DIVISIONS

Leave the El Segundo bell buoy (2ES) to starboard, continue to the finishing line. Continue to instruction 4.3 (course length 29.7 nm).

- 4.3 Round the yellow inflatable offset mark, located south of the Marina del Rey detached breakwater (at approximately 33° 57.352' N 118° 27.582' W), leaving the mark to port. The R/C will attempt to have a strobe on this mark. When 10 boat lengths from this mark, hail the R/C on VHF 68 and inform them of your sail number. Continue to instruction 6.1.
- 5 THE START
- The starting line will be between an orange flag on the RC boat and the summit of Eagle Rock (approx. 0.5 nm from the west end of Catalina Island).
- 6 THE FINISH- ALL DIVISIONS
- The finishing line will be between the green light on the south end of the detached breakwater and an orange flag on the R/C boat (located near the mouth of Ballona Creek). Boats finishing after 1930 shall illuminate their sail number.

- The R/C intends to be on station until 2030. If the R/C is not on station, record your own finish time (GPS) when the green light on the south end of the detached breakwater bears 200° from your bow.
- 6.3 All entries shall record their finish time (GPS) and the sail numbers of any boats ahead of and directly behind (use attached Appendix A). This must be submitted at the DRYC front desk no later than 1200 June 10, 2019. Any penalty for failure to submit, shall be at the discretion of the R/C.
- 6.4 Any boat not finishing by 2230 (Time Limit) will be scored DNF (this changes RRS 35).
- **All retirements must be reported as soon as possible,** but no later than 30 minutes after retirement, to the finish PRO or the DRYC office (see instruction 11).

7 HANDICAP RATINGS / SCORING

- 7.1 For PHRF and Cruising Divisions, PHRF of So. California (PHRF) Area B OWC ratings will apply. Out of area production boats may have Area B OWC adjustments applied, at the discretion of the R/C.
- **7.2** For ORCA entries Time Correction Factors (TCF) will apply.
- 7.3 A boat that DNS, DNF, RET or DSQ shall be scored the number of finishers plus 1. An entry that DNC will score the numbers of individual entries plus 2. This changes RRS A4 and A9.
- 8 PROTESTS
- 8.1 Boats shall notify the R/C of their intention to protest within one hour of finishing, to the finish PRO or the DRYC office (see instruction 11).
- **8.2** Protests (forms available at the DRYC front desk) shall be filed at the DRYC office, no later than 1200 June 10th, 2019 (Protest Time Limit). Hearings will be scheduled for a later date.
- 9 RADIO COMMUNICATION

The R/C will attempt to monitor and announce starting information and recalls on VHF 68.

10 TROPHIES

Individual race, series and perpetual trophies will be awarded at a trophy presentation and pool party on Saturday June 29th, 2019, starting at 1630. Please RSVP with the DRYC office, by June 24th and join us for the party.
