NOTICE OF RACE

You are cordially invited to attend the 62nd Bob Yule Memorial National Capital Regatta, being held at Britannia Yacht Club, Ottawa, on July 13 -14, 2019. Competitors, coaches and their families are welcome before and after these dates. The Organizing Authority **(OA)** is Britannia Yacht Club **(BYC)**.

1. DEFINITIONS

1.1 The notation '**DP**' in a rule in the NoR means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

2. RULES

- **2.1** The Championship will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 2.2 The Prescriptions of Sail Canada apply and can be seen at:

- **2.3** The "Green" fleet allows on-the-water coaching by registered coaches.
- **2.4** Coaches shall not interfere with other boats, subject to jury disqualification from the regatta.
- 2.5 In weather requiring all boats to return to harbour or for other safety issues, all boats (RC, Safety, coaches) boats come under the direction of the RC and shall be able and ready to tow any participants back to harbour. Spectator boats are encouraged to help (see SIs for more information)

3. ADVERTISING

3.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the **OA**.

4. ELIGIBILITY

4.1 Entrants must be members of a Yacht Club recognized by their National Sailing Authority or a member of their Class Association. All boats and equipment must conform to their respective class and/or fleet measurement, equipment and accommodation regulations.

Advance online registration is strongly encouraged. Online registrations will be accepted until 2100 Friday July 12, 2019. In-person registration will take place at the Regatta Office of Britannia Yacht Club on Friday, July 12, 2019 from 1600-2100 hours. At the discretion of the Regatta Chair, and in exceptional circumstances only, registrations for out of town sailors may be accepted Saturday July 13th between 0730-0900. All participants must check in at the Regatta office during the registration periods above to pick up their race kits.

The sailing instructions will be provided at registration, after 1600 hours on Friday, July 12, 2019, at the Regatta Office.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Regatta.

11. SERIES FORMAT AND SCORING

A maximum of 12 races are scheduled with one or more races constituting a series; one drop with five or more races, second drop with ten or more races. The Low Point Scoring System of the of the Racing Rules, Appendix A will apply.

12. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible following the completion of racing on Sunday. Various BYC trophies will be awarded to winners in their respective classes. As well, NCR medallions will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place finishers in each category. Other awards may also be presented.

13. REFUND POLICY

Competitors entering and withdrawing up to Monday July 1, 2019 will be refunded their entry fee, less a \$5.00 administration charge.

14. ACCOMMODATIONS
