Lake Norman Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority for this regatta.

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS) with the following changes:

1.1.1 Appendix V, Alternative penalties V1 and V2 will be in effect. (Changes RRS 44.1)

1.1.2 Appendix A2.1 is changed such that one score will be excluded if more than 5 races are completed.

2. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

Eligible boats may enter the regatta by registering online (<http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19180>). The Regatta is open to boats of the classes that register in accordance with the Notice of Race, including juniors, centerboards, and keelboats.

Boats will be divided into classes as determined by the race committee. One Design Classes will consist of not less than three boats, except for a multi-class Portsmouth handicap fleet. The number and makeup of the PHRF classes will be determined based upon registration. PHRF keelboats must have a current LNKC PHRF certificate number. If you do not have a LNKC PHRF certificate, please apply for one at www.lnkc.com.

3. INDEPENDENCE DAY FUN

The July 4th Regatta is about family, friends, and fun. Bring the family and enjoy the lake. Invite friends and show off the club. Have fun sailing, playing games, dancing and seeing the fireworks.

Early registrations are encouraged for planning purposes. Registration must be completed online and payment by credit card is encouraged. Registrations and payments received **by June 30th** will receive a \$10 discount.

4. REGISTRATION and FEES, cont'd

Fees:

- a. \$55 for Keelboats and Centerboards. \$65 after June 30th.
- b. \$25 for Juniors. \$35 after June 30th.
- c. \$15 Saturday Adult Dinner; \$ 18.00 after June 30th. A limited number of dinners will be available at event and will be cash or check only.
- d. \$10 Saturday Child Dinner (Under 12). A limited number of dinners will be available at event.

Register online even if you are registering the day of the event. **Online dinner reservations might be closed BEFORE the event depending on the number of registrations.** A limited number of dinners will be available at the event.

5. SCHEDULE

Racing will be Saturday and Sunday only. One race will constitute a regatta. On Saturday, the number of races will be determined by the Race Committee. On Sunday, racing continues but with no warning after 1300.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Official Bulletin Board located at the Race Management Center. Copies will be available at registration. PHRF keelboats will race under LNKC Lakewide Sailing Instructions (LSI).

7. THE COURSES

7.1 Courses to be sailed will be as described in the Sailing Instructions.

7.2 PHRF Keelboats on the Down-the-Lake course will be as described in the LNKC LSI.

7.3 One Design Keelboats and Centerboards on the around the buoys course will be windward-leeward.

7.4 The Dingy course (expected classes: Optis, Sunfish, Lasers, 420s) will be windward-leeward.

7.5 All course locations will be in the vicinity of Lake Norman Yacht Club with specific locations to be announced at the Competitors' Meeting. Final fleet and course assignments are at the discretion of the race committee.

8. PENALTY SYSTEM

Appendix V Alternative Penalties V1 and V2 will be in effect (Changes RRS 44.1).

9. SCORING

Scoring will be Low Point Scoring System Appendix A, except that one race will be excluded if more than 5 races are completed (changes RRS A2.1). Keelboats will race under PHRF Time on Distance; PHRF classes may be further divided based on the entries received. A minimum of one race constitutes a Regatta for all fleets

10. AWARDS

Trophies will be awarded based on number of boats registered by June 30, 2019, as follows:

# boats in fleet	trophies
3-5	1
6-9	2
10-13	3
14+	4

11. LAUNCHING & FACILITIES

LNYC has two launch ramps suitable for trailer launching of boats up to 33', as well as a single point hoist (4000lb). Camping is welcome. Shower and restroom facilities are available at the Clubhouse & the Pavilion. Open fires are not permitted at LNYC. **PETS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT LNYC ON REGATTA WEEKENDS.**

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
