Fairhope Yacht Club welcomes you to the 77th Annual Wadewitz Regatta. We look forward to providing you a great competition and event. Please note the following details about this weekend:

Arrival

Vehicle Parking:

Parking at the club will be limited to the first row of the main lot, side lots, and the lot at the Junior Yacht Club. On Saturday and Sunday, the club will provide overflow parking for competitors at Fairhope Elementary School on Section St., with shuttle service back to the club. Please refer to the attached map for details.

Boat Parking:

- Trailered vessels, including Vipers and Lightnings will be stored in the west half of the main lot, in front of Fairhope Yacht Club, behind the orange barricades.
- Dollied vessels, including 420's, Lasers, Sunfish, and Opti's, will be stored in the area around the boat barn south of the clubhouse, or near the beach. Tow any empty trailers for these vessels to the lot at the corner of Section & Volanta, at the top of the hill, next to Fairhope Boat Company.

***Competitors arriving with trailers, please do NOT block traffic moving through the lot when stopping to unload your boats.

Mooring:

Any visiting motor yacht, please moor at the basin alongside the Gazebo or at the end of any T-Pier that is available during the weekend.

Competitor Check-In:

One Design & Capdevielle Check-in will be in the FYC Ballroom, upstairs in the clubhouse from **9-11am on Saturday**. All competitors must check in to verify or update their information with officials at this time. Junior competitors must have their parents present to sign for them. Parent/Spectator flags will be available for individuals wishing to take their boats out to a course.

Guest Membership Cards:

Visitors are **required** to register for a temporary membership card to use at the club for the weekend. GYA reciprocity will not be available, and cash payment will be severely limited during the regatta.
