

# MAYRA Flying Scot Championship Regatta



## Notice of Race (modified 7/14/2019):

MAYRA Flying Scot Championship to be held July 20<sup>th</sup> 2019

The Avalon Yacht Club, the Yacht Club of Stone Harbor and Flying Scot Fleets 192 and 208 invite all Flying Scot sailors to compete in the **2019 MAYRA Flying Scot Championship** on the Great Sound. All sailors and their guests are welcome to use the facilities of both yacht clubs for the duration of the event. Visiting boats are invited to launch from either the AYC or the YCSH.

1. **Rules.** The race will be governed by *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the FSSA Class Rules, and the Sailing Instructions.
2. **Notice to Competitors.** Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice boards located at the Avalon Yacht Club and the Yacht Club of Stone Harbor.
3. **Eligibility.** The event is open to all Flying Scot class sailboats. Additional fleets may be eligible by contacting the PRO no later than July 13<sup>th</sup> 2019.
4. **Sears Qualification.** The 2019 MAYRA Flying Scot Championship will serve as MAYRA's Qualifier for the 2020 US Sailing Area C Sears Championship. The date and location of the 2020 Area C Sears Championship is TBD but it typically occurs in the spring of each year.

The Sears Championship is a part of US Sailing's Junior Championship series and is sailed in triple handed boats. The US Sailing age limitation for the Sears Championship is such that sailors may not have reached their 19<sup>th</sup> birthday in the calendar year of the event.

For the purposes of MAYRA Qualification, the skipper with the lowest points score who has not reached his/her 18<sup>th</sup> birthday during 2019, shall qualify as MAYRA's representative to the 2020 Area C Sears Championship.

MAYRA will pay the registration fees for the 2020 Area C Sears Championship for the qualifying team.

5. **Sailing Instructions.** Sailing Instructions will be provided online and at the skippers meeting on the evening before race day.

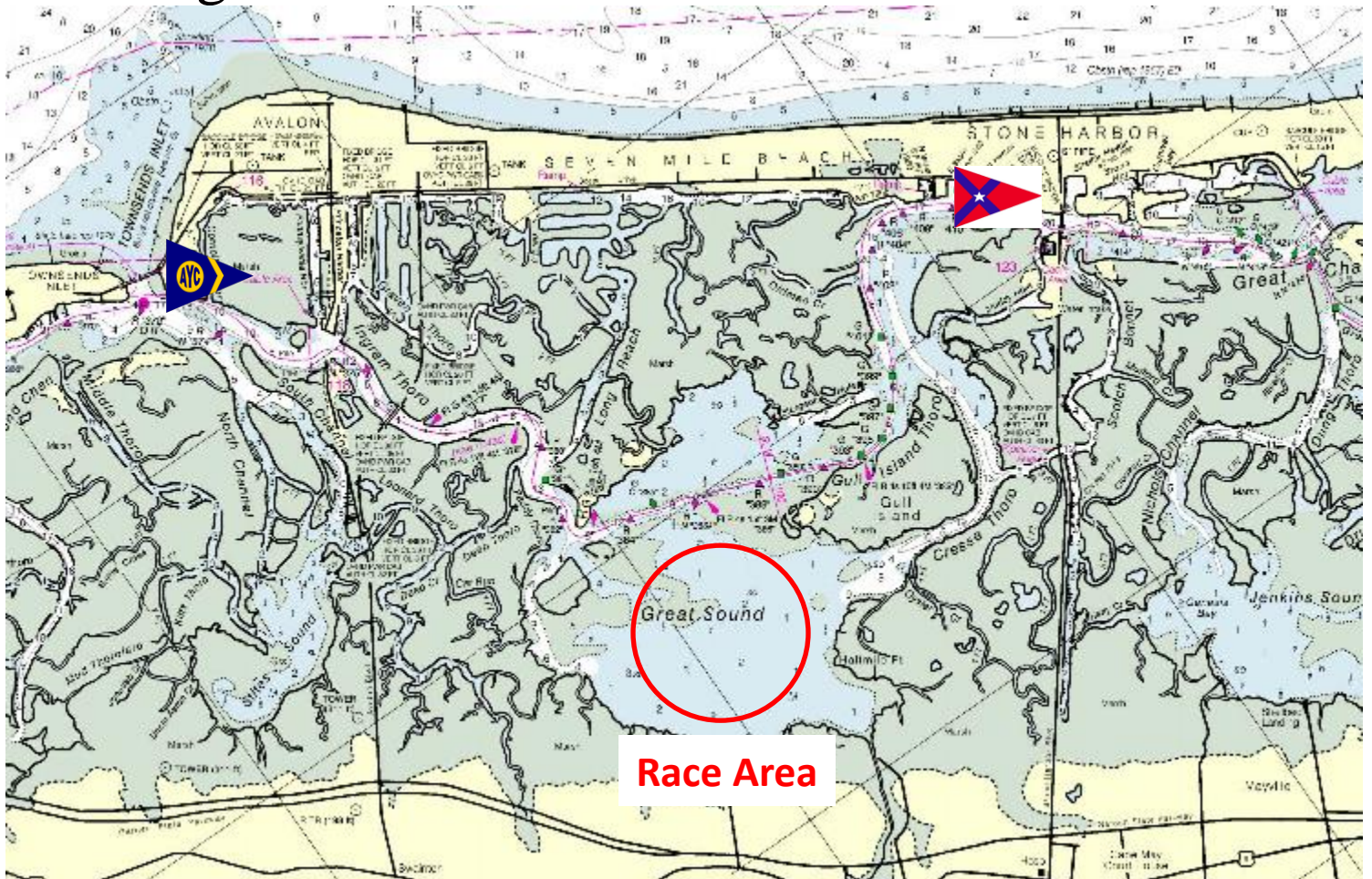
