#### 1. RULES

1.1 The event shall be governed by:

1.1.1 ISAF Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS)- Windsurf Competition Rules(WCR).

1.1.6 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions will take precedence.

1.1.7 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.2 Classes eligible for entry include Open Windfoil.

#### 3. Divisions

3.1 The participating classes and divisions will be: Open Windfoil, U19 Windfoil

#### 4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$140 USD if received by October 11<sup>th</sup>.

4.2 The entry fee for youth (under 21) competitors will be \$125 USD if received by October 11th

4.3 A late fee of \$15 USD will be added for all entries received after October 11th.

4.3 Late registration will be available onsite October 25 from 1600 to 1900.

4.4 Fee includes three lunches, two dinners, and a t-shirt.

## **8. VENUE**

8.1 Racing will take place at one of three different locations. Competitors will be informed of the launching venue by 1900 the night before racing via email through regatta networks. The three launching venues include:

1. Morgan Park 2650 Gulf Blvd, Belleair Beach, FL 33786
2. Clearwater Community Sailing Center 1001 Gulf Blvd Clearwater FL 33767
3. North Side of Dunedin Causeway 61 Causeway Blvd, Dunedin, FL 34698 The address listed is for the kayak rental on the south side of the causeway. Meet across from this on the north side of the causeway.

## **9. SCORING**

9.1 One races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

9.2(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 to 11 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## **10. PRIZES**

10.1 Awards will be given to 1-3 for each division with over 10 boards pre-registered by 10-11-2019. In divisions with less than ten boards pre-registered by 10-11-2019 only first place will be awarded.

## **11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.

## **12. Safety**

12.1 Personal buoyancy and helmet is mandatory for competitors under 19.

12.2 Mandatory helmet use is required for all competitors when puffs exceed 15 knots.
