NOTICE OF RACE

The Jessica Uniack Memorial Beach to Bay Race will be hosted by Long Beach Yacht Club (LBYC). LBYC is located at 6201 Appian Way, Long Beach CA 90803. Phone number is (562) 598-9401. Club and Event information are available at www.lbyc.org.

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

The Organizing Authority (OA) will be the Long Beach Yacht Club (LBYC)

2. VENUE

The venue will be the vicinity of Long Beach Harbor and Alamitos Bay

3. SCHEDULE (PROVISIONAL)

- 3.1 Schedule
 - (a) Check-in opens at 8:00am Thursday July 18
 - (b) Late Registration and check-in closes at 9:00am Thursday July 18
 - (c) Skippers briefing shall be at 9:00am
 - (d) Coaches/Spectator briefing shall be at 9:15am
 - (e) First warning is 9:41am
 - (f) Pool Deck opens at 12:00noon
 - (g) The Prize Giving will be held approx. 1 hour after the last boat finishes.
- 3.2 Unless excused by the OA, attendance at the following is mandatory:
 - (a) Initial briefing for skippers
 - (b) Prize giving for final skippers and crews

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Sailing Instructions will be available at check-in on Thursday morning

5. SKIPPERS ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

- 5.1 The regatta is open to all Junior Sailors age 17 and under at the scheduled date of the event.
- 5.2 Eligible boats may enter by submitting the entry form and paying the entry fee online www.lbyc.org, under the Sailing and Racing dropdown menu. An entry is not considered complete until the entry fee has been paid. All entry fees are non-refundable.

6. ENTRIES

- 6.1 The Skipper shall be entered upon completion of registration. All payments shall be in US Dollars or by Credit Card.
- 6.2 The entry fee is \$25 if paid by 1700hrs July 15. Late Entry fee will be \$35 and is accepted up until the close of check in at the beach.
- 6.3 Entry fees paid by 1700hrs July 15 will receive a free regatta t-shirt. Entries after July 15 will not be guaranteed a t-shirt.

7. RULES

7.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the RRS, this NOR and SI and includes Appendix U.

- 7.2 USCG approved PFD's shall be worn at all times by competitors while on the water, other than brief periods while adding or removing clothing. The 'Y' flag will not be flown. This changes RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4.
- 7.3 US Sailing Prescriptions 63.2, and 63.4 are deleted.

8. COURSE

A course chart will be distributed to all competitors at check in. The Course is a 5 nautical mile race starting from the corner of Alamitos Beach near Island Grissom. Racers race along the beach passing the Belmont Memorial Veterans Pier and in the Jetty of Alamitos Bay finishing in front of Long Beach Yacht Club.

9. PRIZES

- 9.1 The principal prize will be the Jessica Uniack Perpetual Trophy. This trophy is awarded to the winner of the biggest fleet. Prizes will be awarded to the top group of finishers in each fleet.
- 9.2 The OA may reduce or eliminate a prize in the case of misconduct, refusal to comply with any reasonable request, including attendance at the official functions.
- 9.3 Trophies will be awarded to the top three crews

10. MEDIA, IMAGES AND SOUND

The OA may require television personnel (or dummies) and/or sponsor representatives and equipment to be carried on board while racing or practice and may require competitors to be available for interviews. The OA shall have the right to use any and all images and sound recorded during the event free of charge.

11. COACH BOATS

- 11.1 Coach boats shall display identification of the team being coached.
- 11.2 The OA will provide limited berthing for coach boats during the event, subject to availability.
- 11.3 Any interference by a coach boat with the racing or event organization may result in a penalty applied at the discretion of the IJ or PC to the associated skipper or team.

12. OTHER REQUIREMENTS

None

Competitors in this event are participating entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. By Participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the OA and any related parties from any and all Liability associated with participation in this event to the fullest extent permitted by law.
