## 1. RULES

- 1.1 The Organizing Authority will govern the regatta by the rules as defined in the 2017-2020 edition of *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS), the <u>ISSA Procedural Rules</u>, <u>the SEISA District Rules</u>, <u>the Cressy Conditions</u>, this Notice of Race, and the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2 Appendix P may be enforced and will be modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 14(c).
- 1.3 In accordance with RRS 70.5(a), decisions of the protest committee are final. US SAILING's permission has been granted.

#### 2. SAFETY

- 2.1 All competitors must wear USCG approved, non-inflatable lifejackets in good repair, at all time, while on the water, except to quickly change clothing.
- 2.2 Only a team uniform/pinnie may be worn outside the life jacket.

## 3. ELIGIBILITY

- 3.1 Competing schools must be current active members of ISSA and meet ISSA eligibility rules as prescribed in the Procedural Rules. [Payment of \$150 per high school must be made to SEISA as annual membership dues for the current school year prior to entry deadline, please see instructions at https://registration.hssailing.org/
- 3.2 Competitors must be in 9th 12th grade.
- 3.3 Competitors must be accompanied by a designated adult team leader/chaperone who is responsible for and must accompany the school's team at the regatta site. This adult may be an adviser, coach, or parent recognized by the school.
- 3.4 Competitors must be registered (names listed) under their High School in the ISSA database.
- 3.5 Per ISSA PR 2.5, a team uniform/pinnie shall be worn.

# 4. ENTRY

4.1 Entry fee is \$100 per competitor. Please see Notice of Race 4.2 for additional registration information. ALL ENTRY FEES MUST BE PAID THROUGH THE LASER GCC'S SITE. There are no duplicate fees. All entries, forms & fees must be received (emailed to Laura Burns) by September 13, 2019. - **4.2** All competitors registering/entering the SEISA Single-handed Champs must also be fully registered/entered in the Laser GCCs. - 4.4 Meals will be provided, as outlined in Notice of Race 6.1, Schedule of Events.
- 4.5 Please bring your own reusable water bottle. Water will be available to all competitors to refill their water bottles, both on shore and on the water.

#### 5. BOATS

This is a BYOB event. Full Rig Laser or Radial Rig Laser.

6.2 The Race Committee will post any changes to schedule on the notice board by 1800 the day before the changes go into effect.

# 7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will only be available online, closer to the event start date, at: hssailing.org

#### 8. RACING AREA

All races will be sailed in the Mississippi Sound in front of PCYC.

#### 9. STARTS

All races shall be started using RRS 26, 29 and 30. This changes ISSA PR 7.8 (a)(b).

## 10. SCORING

- 10.1 The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A, will apply as modified by ISSA Procedural Rule 9, except that no score will be excluded.
- 10.2 SEISA Single-handed Champs entrants will be scored twice; in the Laser GCCs and again separately for the SEISA Single-handed Champs.
- 10.3 Twelve (12) or more races are scheduled; three (3) completed races will constitute a regatta.

#### 11. COURSES

Based on conditions, the race committee will determine the courses to be sailed.

#### 12. COACHING

- 12.1 Team leaders, chaperones, coaches, parents, advisors and other support personnel will be permitted to go afloat on race days as long as they stay well outside the racing, starting and finishing areas.
- 12.2 If there are support personnel who wish to go afloat but do not have a boat, every attempt will be made to provide on the water access.
- 12.3 Per ISSA PR 8(b), any sailor who intends to protest MUST report to the race committee BEFORE talking with any support personnel in coach boats. Failure to do this may be grounds for closing the protest hearing. This changes RRS 61.

#### 13. PRIZES

- 13.1 Prizes will be awarded for first and second place in each fleet.
- 13.2 First place in each fleet will qualify for the 2019 ISSA CRESSY HIGH SCHOOL SINGLEHANDED CHAMPIONSHIP Nov 2-3, 2019, hosted by PCISA/UC Santa Barbara/Santa Barbara Yacht Club, 130 HARBOR WAY, SANTA BARBARA, CA 93109.

## 14. IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ALL REGATTA CONTESTANTS:

No contestant shall use, either on or off the water, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine, or distilled spirits, each as defined in Chapter 51 of the US Internal Revenue Code and intended for beverage use), or marijuana, cocaine, or any other controlled substance (as defined in 21 US Code 802), the possession of which, by that contestant is unlawful under 21 US Code 841. Infringements of this regulation and/or other discipline expectations occurring during September 29-30, 2018, may be the basis for a hearing under Rule 69.1 The protest committee for such a hearing shall be the regatta chairperson, a member of the ISSA BOD, and the protest committee chairperson. This protest committee shall, at a time and place selected by them, meet to hear said protest, and their decision to impose scoring penalties, or other sanctions they alone deem appropriate, including summary removal from the regatta, shall be final, without appeal.
