# NOTICE OF RACE

# 1) RULES

- a) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* and including the <u>DragonFlite 95 Restricted Class Rules</u> (DF95-RCR).
- b) RRS Appendix E will apply.

### 2) ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- a) The regatta is open to all DragonFlite 95 boats.

- c) Entry forms and fees are due by Wednesday, September 25th at 1100 hours.
- d) Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Race Committee.
- e) The following restrictions on the number of boats apply: Forty-five (45). A waiting list will be established and the Race Committee reserves the right to increase the number of competitors.

## 3) FEES

- a) The entry fee of \$55 is due at the time of registration and includes one Saturday night dinner wristband and two drink tickets.
- b) Additional dinner wristbands may be purchased in the regatta store for \$20
- c) Box lunches may be purchased in the <u>regatta store</u> for \$10.

### 8) SCORING

- a) The scoring system is the AMYA Heat Management System (HMS).
- b) The fleet will be divided into heats of no more than 15 boats

### 9) PRIZES
