### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.

#### 2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to boats of the Albacore, Chesapeake 20, Double-Handed Catamaran, Flying Scot, Laser, Penguin, Windmill, and Single-Handed Catamaran classes that satisfy the requirements of its class rules.
- 2.2 Any class with 3 or more boats may be given a start at the discretion of the Race Committee and PRO.

#### 3 ENTRY

- 3.1 Regular online registration ends at midnight on Wednesday, August 28 on the Regatta's Regatta Network site.

#### 4 FEES

- 4.1 Required fees are as follows:

Registration Type	Fee
Single Handed Classes (Penguins included)	\$35
Double-Handed Classes	\$45
US Sailing member discount	\$5
Late registration fee (after 23:59 on 8/28)	\$10
Dinner	\$19 per person

Cancellation prior to the first day of racing will be refunded, minus a 10% fee.

## 8 SCHEDULE

### 8.1 Saturday

0830	Late on-site registration opens in the clubhouse
0915	Late on-site registration closed
0930	Competitors' meeting (at flagpole or inside if raining)
1100	First warning signal.
1700	Dinner, band, and bar start for the 90th Celebration

*The Race Committee (RC) will announce the order of starts for the first race at the competitors' meeting.*

### 8.2 Sunday

1030	First warning signal for all classes
1430	No races will start after this time

Awards will follow racing.

### 8.3 Number of Races:

There is no limit to the number of races. The committee will attempt to maximize racing for the conditions available.

## 9 PRIZES

9.1 For each class, prizes will be given to the first-place finisher in classes with three or fewer entries, the first two finishers in classes with six or fewer entries, and the first three finishers in classes with seven or more entries. Prizes for the A-Cat class will be awarded for Foiling and Classic boats as separate classes.

9.2 The Billy Heintz Memorial perpetual trophy will be awarded to first place finisher in the class with the largest number of registered competitors.

## 10 COURSES

10.1 Courses will be set around racing marks as declared in the Sailing Instructions.

## 11 PENALTY SYSTEM

11.1 For the Multihull (catamaran) classes, RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.
