ORGANIZING AUTHORITY and MANAGEMENT: The organizing authorities for this race are

Redondo Beach Yacht Club (RBYC), King Harbor Yacht Club (KHYC) and Shoreline Yacht Club (SYC). The Race Committees of these yacht clubs will jointly manage this race.

1.0 RULES:

1.1 This race shall be governed by the current 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), except as modified by the Notice of Race and/or the Sailing Instructions.

1.2 Compliance with US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements for coastal racing are recommended, <u>http://www.ussailing.org/safety/equipment-and-reqyurenebts/*In</u> Long Beach Harbor, keep clear of all non-racers and Deep Keel commercial traffic.

2.0 ENTRY: Sailboats of LOA >= 19' are invited. Competitors may register in advance by completing the Event Registration Form online at Regatta Network (event 19524). The deadline for registration is 1800, August 16, 2019. Late entries accepted with approval of Race Committee.

2.1 Entry Fee is \$30.00

2.2 CLASSES:

Classes will be established based on entries. There are (3) PHRF classes planned A, B, and C.

A minimum of (3) yachts are required to establish a One Design class.

Verified Non-spin offset is optional in all classes. Classes may be combined for competitive reasons.

3.0 COURSE: The start line will be in the area of King Harbor "S" mark, First warning will be at 11:30.

The finish will be off the stern of the Queen Mary. Handicap distance is 23.8 nm. **4.0 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:**

The sailing instructions will be available on Regatta Network no later than

8/14/19. For King Harbor marks, please see links to KHYC mark guide on Regatta Network. Note: they are in deg*min'sec".

5.0 SCORING: Handicap classes will use PHRF-regional RLC Base RATINGS, time on distance.
