Notice of Race

September 21 and 22, 2019

Richmond Yacht Club, Richmond, California

1. RULES:

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. Rule 40 is changed as follows: All competitors shall wear personal flotation devices while racing, except briefly while changing or adjusting clothing or personal equipment. Flag Y will not be displayed.
- 1.3. Appendix V1 (Penalty at the Time of an Incident) and V2 (Penalty Taken After a Race) shall apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all centerboard monohull dinghies.
- 2.2. Entry must be completed online at www.richmondyc.org.
- 2.3. **Early Registration Deadline:** A class must have 4 or more boats registered by Monday, 9th of September to ensure that their class will receive a start.
- 2.4. **Final Registration** closes on Thursday, September 19 at 21:00 PDT.
- 2.5. Entry fee will be as follows:

3. SCHEDULE OF RACING:

- 3.1. Skippers Meeting for all fleets Saturday, 10:00 am
- 3.2. Seven (7) races are scheduled, with up to Five (5) races planned for Saturday
- 3.3. First Warning for Potrero Reach fleets 11:30 am
- 3.4. First Warning for Southampton and/or Keller Cove area fleets 12:00 pm
- 3.5. Subsequence races immediately after finish of first race
- 3.6. No race shall be started after 16:00 pm PDT

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The Sailing Instructions will be available online after 14:00 PDT on Friday, Sept.20 at www.richmondyc.org.

5. COURSES AND LOCATION: The courses will be windward-leeward using inflated temporary marks. The course areas to be sailed are (1) Potrero Reach, (2) Keller Cove and (3) an area approximately ¾ nm

Southeast of the Richmond Breakwater between Brooks Island and Pt Blunt (“Brooks Island”). Number of racing areas to be determined subsequent to Early Registration deadline.

4. **SCORING:** The Low Point system will apply. Two races will constitute a series. If more than six (6) races are completed there will be one (1) throw out. Open Class will be scored using the current Portsmouth Handicap ratings provided by US Sailing, which may not correspond with the data provided by Regatta Network.
7. **DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY:** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
8. **SOCIAL AND TROPHIES:** Complementary appetizers after Saturday and Sunday racing. There will be a trophy presentation on Saturday for the Potrero Reach course, and for all other fleets on Sunday after racing.
