Start:	Between yellow flag on Race Committee boat and Region 2, Chesapeake Bay Area Mark "T" (Baltimore Light).		
Signals:	RRS 26 (Starting Races): First Signal 1055 hrs. See event SI's for further details.		
Course:	To be displayed by the RC at the time of the race, using marks listed in the 2019 GSI as Region 2, Chesapeake Bay Area Standard Racing Marks. A course for the slower fleets will be posted first, BREAK – then longer course posted for remaining classes. The RC plans to offer two courses depending on wind speed and direction. Course notice will be provided 24 hours prior to event start or earlier if possible, via email to all registrants.
