Sail as many races as conditions allow. <u>~6:00pm Dinner</u> -Grilling at the Pavilion (weather permitting).

Sunday, <u>9:30am 1st Warning</u>. Awards around 1:30 pm (location to be determined).

**Regatta Fee:** Laser \$50, Radial \$40 and 4.7 \$20. Please register early to help with food, drink and personnel management. Brunch and Dinner is optional with additional purchases available. Cutoff for food purchase is Thursday at noon.

**Registration:** Only available Online at Regatta Network. Registration, Check-in and changes Online will be at the OB Saturday morning.

**Rules:** This event will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020. This includes US Sailing Prescriptions and the Rules of the Int'I Laser Class Association. Sailing Instructions will be provided Online prior to the event. Printed copies will also be available.

**Courses:** Windward - Leeward with a finish upwind (at the race committee's discretion).

**Races:** 10 races with 1 throw-out every 6 races using the Standard Low-Point system. 1 race completed constitutes a finished regatta.

**Awards:** 3 places for Laser, 3 for Radial and 3 for 4.7. We will also recognize the top Apprentice Master 35-44, Master 45-54, Grand Master 55-64, Great Grand Master 65-74 and Legends 75 and older!

**Bottled Water:** Entry fee includes bottle water. It would also be a good idea to bring additional supplies and please manage the empties responsibly!
