1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the current rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. The first sentence of RRS A2 is changed to read "Each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores except when 6 or more races have been scored, each boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score".
- 1.3. US Sailing Prescriptions to Rule 63.2 will not apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, AND PLACEMENT

- 2.1. This event is open to all Hobie Waves.
- 2.2. Eligible boats shall register using online registration by the specified deadlines
- 2.3. Online registration is available at US Sailing: Regattanetwork.com

3. FEES

3.1. Entry fees received before on or **before OCTOBER 1,2019** are as follows:

- 4.1. Multiple back to back races are scheduled for each day. No race may be started after 2:00 pm on Sunday.

5. MEASUREMENT

- 5.1. E ach boat shall conform to the international class rules.
- 5.2. All sails will be subject to measurement.
- 5.3. Only one sail may be used during the regatta. If a competitor's sail is damaged beyond repair they may appeal to the Organizing Authority to substitute another measured and approved sail.
- 5.4. A boat and/or its equipment may be inspected, or directed to a place for inspection, at any time for compliance with Class Rules, the Sailing Instructions, and this Notice of Race.
- 5.5 Each boat shall display a bow number or letter on the outside of each hull. No two boats shall have the same number.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 6.1. Race packets, including Sailing Instructions will be available on Thursday, October 24th from 4:00 pm 7:00pma s well as Fri. at the Pensacola Beach Yacht Club. Sailing Instructions MAY be posted on Regatta Network Prior to regatta.
- 6.2 In case of any discrepancy between the NOR and Sailing Instructions, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedent.

7. VENUE

7.1. All racing will take place on the Near Shore waters of Quietwater beach by Key Sailing.

8. COURSES

8.1 The courses sailed will include: Triangle Windward- Leeward and/or Windward- Leeward.

9. SCORING

- 9.1. The Low-Point System of Appendix A will be used.
- 9.2. Also see Paragraph 1. Rules: Sec 1.3 of this NOR
- 9.3. One race will constitute a regatta with the intension to have 12–15 races or more if conditions allow.

10. HAUL-OUT RESTRICTIONS

10.1. Unrestricted for all Competitors.

11. AWARDS

- 11.1. Prizes will be awarded for First Fifth place Overall.
- 11.2. Prizes will be awarded for First Third place Senior (over 65) division
