NOTICE OF RACE

The organizing authority is Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club (SMWYC), 13589 Mindanao Way, Marina Del Rey, CA 90292. (310) 827-7692.

1. <u>Rules:</u>

- 1.1. The race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS) except as changed herein or by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. PHRF of Southern California (PHRF SoCal) "Marine Industry Racer Rule" will not apply.

2. Eligibility:

2.1. This regatta is open to handicap boats that have a valid PHRF SoCal Rating Certificate and to one-design keelboats.

3. Entry:

- 3.1. Eligible boats must enter the race online at Regatta Network: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_registration_form.php?regatta_id=1969</u> <u>8</u>
- 3.2. Entries must be received by 1500, Friday October 4, 2019.
- 3.3. The entry fee is \$35.00, \$30.00 for US Sailing Members.

4. Classes:

- 4.1. One-design keelboats must have a minimum of three (3) paid entries prior to the entry deadline to establish a class. Those with the same PHRF SoCal Area B W/L rating may be combined to establish a Level Rating class. Those that do not establish a class may compete in the PHRF Racing Division, if they are in compliance with the handicap boat requirements per NOR 2.1
- 4.2. Handicap boats will compete in either a PHRF Racing or a PHRF Cruising Division and must have a minimum of three (3) paid entries prior to the entry deadline to establish a Division.
- 4.3. Classes, class flags and the order of starts will be posted on the official notice board outside the main office at Santa Monica Windjammers Yacht Club, online at Regatta Network and <u>www.smwyc.org</u> no later than 0930 hours on Saturday, October 5.

5. <u>Schedule:</u>

Thursday, October 31800Sailing Instructions postedFriday, October 41500Deadline to EnterSaturday, October 50930Class Flags and Order of Starts for the 1st race will be posted.Saturday, October 51155First warning signal – subsequent races to start ASAP

6. Sailing Instructions:

Sailing Instructions will be ava<u>il</u>able at SMWYC, online at <u>www.smwyc.org</u> and may be posted on the Regatta Network event website page no later than 1800 hours on Thursday, October 3, 2019

7. The Courses:

Courses will be windward/leeward for racing divisions and random leg for cruising divisions using marks on Course Chart 17.

8. <u>Scoring:</u>

- 8.1 All race scores will count. This changes RRS A2.1
- 8.2 PHRF Classes will use So Cal PHRF Area B Ratings.
- 8.3 Scoring for PHRF classes will be calculated using the time on distance method.
- 8.4 One (1) race must be completed to constitute a regatta.

9. Radio Communication:

While on the water, the RC may communicate with competing boats via VHF radio

10.<u>Awards:</u>

Awards will be given in each class. Trophies will be presented at SMWYC after racing.
