NOTICE OF RACE

SANTA CRUZ, CA

1. Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*.
- 1.2. The first sentence of RRS 40 is changed so that competitors shall comply with the obligations of RRS 40 (wear a PFD) whether or not the Race Committee displays flag Y with one sound.

2. Notice to Competitors

- 2.1. Notices to Competitors will be posted on the Official Notice Board and may be posted on-line.
- 2.2. The SCYC Official Notice Board is located in the northeast window of the Clubhouse, upper level.
- 2.3. On the water, the Race Committee may use VHF channel 68 for communication.

3. Eligibility, Divisions, and Entry

- 3.1. Boats holding a valid 2019 Monterey Bay PHRF certificate are eligible to enter this event.
- 3.2. There will be Four PHRF divisions as follows: Spinnaker, Non-Spinnaker, Families with children 12 and under, and Families with children 13 and older.
- 3.3. Boats racing shall have exactly two persons on board, one male and one female, except for the family division. Final division assignments will be made at the competitors' meeting.
- 3.4. Eligible boats may only register online at <u>http://www.scyc.org/racing</u> before 1035 hours Saturday, September 28, 2019.
- 3.5. The entry fee is \$45.00 if registered by 2000 hour on Wednesday, September 25, 2019. The late entry fee of \$60.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on Wednesday, September 25, 2019.

4. Schedule

- 4.1. A competitors' meeting will be held at 1100 hours on September 28, 2019 at the SCYC club house.
- 4.2. The scheduled time of the warning signal is 1255 hours.
- 4.3. One race is scheduled. One race will constitute a Regatta.
- 5. Sailing Instructions The Sailing Instructions will be available at the competitors' meeting. They may be posted earlier on the SCYC website.
- 6. Venue Racing will be around fixed buoys in Monterey Bay. The racing area will be within a 3.5 mile radius of the Santa Cruz Small Craft Harbor west jetty.
- 7. Courses Courses will be distributed with the Sailing Instructions.
- 8. **Prizes -** Prizes will be given at the discretion of the organizing authority and awarded at SCYC clubhouse following the regatta.
