NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, 2017 – 2020 (RRS) and the rules of the International Star Class Racing Association (STCR).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all Star Class boats that comply with STCR 21 and 26.4.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may register by going to the TAYC website (<u>www.tayc.com/racing</u>) and completing the entry form for the event. Entry forms must be received no later than 0900 Saturday, September 28. If a Novice Skipper, please identify yourself on entry.

3 FEES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$160 per boat, payable no later than 0900 September 28. Entry fee includes 2 Continental breakfasts Saturday and Sunday, 2 box lunches Saturday, 2 dinners Saturday night and 2 hors d'oeuvres Sunday.
- 3.2 Additional dinners may be purchased for \$45 each and additional lunches for \$9 each.

4 MEASUREMENT

4.1 Boats and sails shall comply with all aspects of the ISCYRA rules.

 - 0900 Competitors' Meeting 5 races are scheduled
 - 1055 Warning signal for first race, subsequent races to follow
 - 1800 Cocktails Cash bar
 - Dinner Tenderloin of beef and crab imperial, red roasted potatoes, green beans with shallots, garden salad with house vinaigrette dressing, rolls, Dutch apple pie ala mode

5.3 Sunday, September 29

0900 Coffee, Continental breakfast

- 1025 Warning signal for first race, second race to follow; no start after 1400
- Post Race Cash bar, trophy presentation, hors d'oeuvres: Baked crab dip, oyster ½ shell and Black Pearl style, chicken Satay w/ peanut sauce, baked spanakopita, assorted seasonal vegetable tray w/ onion dip, cheese & crackers, fresh baked cookies

6 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The Sailing Instructions will be available on the event website no later than 1600 Friday, September 27 and in the Clubhouse on race mornings.

7 THE VENUE

7.1 Racing will be in the Tred Avon River or the Choptank River south of the Choptank River Light, depending upon weather.

8 SCORING

- 8.1 RRS Appendix A4, Low Point System, will apply.
- 8.2 One race must be completed to constitute the series.
- 8.3 If more than 4 races are completed, a boat's worst score will be excluded from her total score.

9 LAUNCHING

9.1 Boats may launch and haul at TAYC. Trailers must be stored in designated areas clear of the hoist and access lanes. No vehicles may drive on dock.

10 PRIZES

- 10.1 Prizes will be awarded as follows: 1, 2 and 3 overall for the weekend.
- 10.2 Special prizes may also be awarded: <u>AB Streeton Trophy</u>: Winning boat after Saturday's racing. <u>North Emory Bartlett Trophy</u>: Winning boat for Sunday's races. <u>Novice Skipper</u>: Best overall score among novice skippers.
- 10.3 Results will be posted at <u>www.tayc.com/racing</u>.
