1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing including Appendix B, Windsurfing Competition Rules*.

1.2 If there is a conflict between languages, the English text will take precedence.

1.3 Class rules will apply to each class.

2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

2.1 Notices to competitors will be posted on the official notice board located in between the shop and the bathrooms.

3. CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Any change to the sailing instructions will be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except to the extent that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 1800 on the day before it will take effect.

5. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

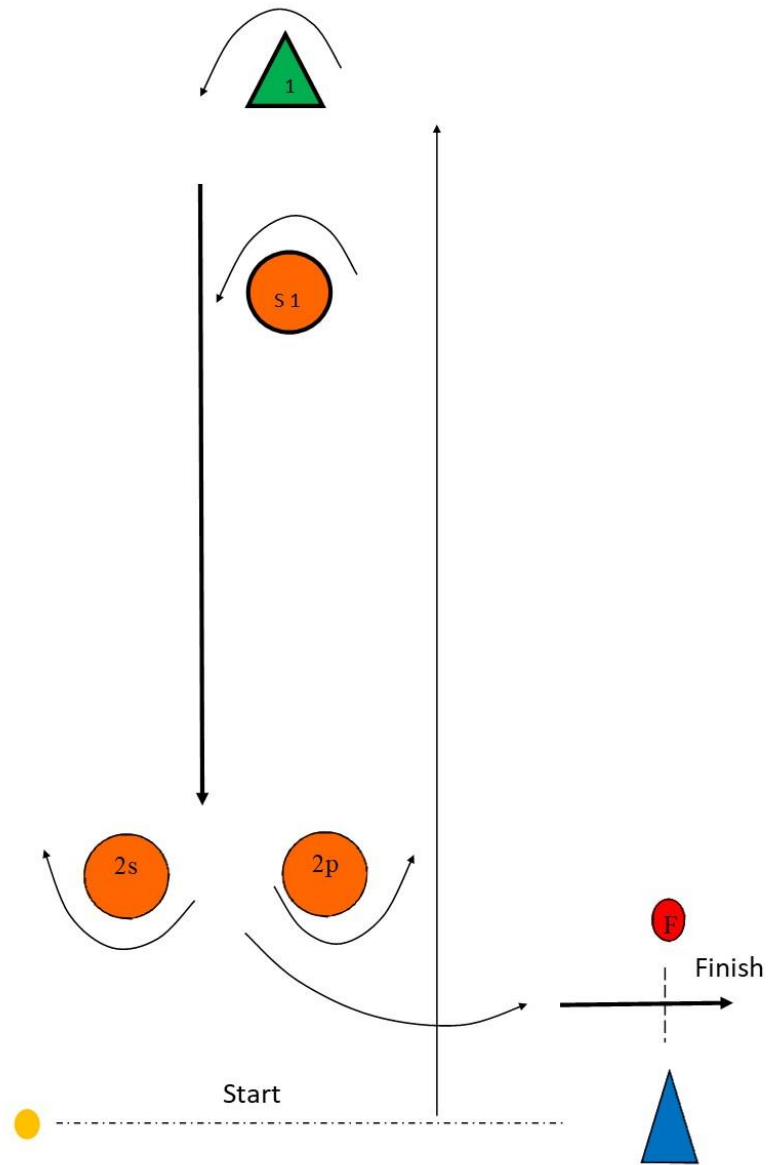
5.1 Signals made ashore will be on the main flag pole.

6.1 The finishing line will be between a committee boat flying an Orange Flag and the finishing mark.
