1.1.3 The class rules of the participating classes will apply as amended by the sailing instructions.

1.2 If there is a conflict between this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the Sailing instructions will take precedence.

1.3 No national authority prescriptions will apply.

2. ELIGIBILITY and ENTRY

2.1 A Minimum of 5 competitors is required to constitute a division. Those entries accepted that do not constitute a division may sail another division as defined by the race committee.

3. Divisions

- 3.1 The participating classes and divisions will be:
- 3.1.2 Kona Class Men, Women, Youth 18 and Under, Masters 65+
- 3.1.3 Longboard Class Men, Women
- 3.1.4 RSX Class Men, Women
- 3.1.5 Techno 293 U15, U17
- 3.1.6 Green fleet, sailors with less than a year of racing experience and sails 5.8 or smaller

4. FEES

4.1 The entry fee for adult competitors is \$100 USD if received by October 19 at 2300 a late fee \$15

USD will be added for entries after October 19th.

4.2 The entry fee for youth(under 21) competitors will be \$100 USD if received by October 19th

and a late fee of \$15 USD will be added for entries received after October 19th.

4.3 Late registration will be available onsite November 1st from 1600 to 1900.

4.4 Fee includes two lunches, one dinner, and a t-shirt.

9. SCORING

9.1 One races are required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

9.2(a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When 5 to 11 races have been completed, a board's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10. PRIZES

10.1 Awards will be given to 1-3 for each division with over 10 boards pre-registered by 10-19-19. In divisions with less than ten boards pre-registered by 3-20-19 only first place will be awarded.
