1. RULES

The current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Corinthian Sailing Association Great Lake Race (GLR) Sailing Instructions will govern the Race. Corinthian Sailing Association will administer the Race.

It is strongly encouraged that all racers sign up for RACEQs and use this tracker for the race.

2. DIVISIONS

PHRF – Spinnaker, Boats with X or S designation on the GYA PHRF Certificate, Non-Spinnaker, and Multihull divisions. Divisions may be broken into classes. 3 Boats can make a class. ORRez will be shadow scored with overall winner declared for that Division as well.

3. ELIGIBILITY

Competitors: The race is open to all. Competitors need not be a member of a Yacht Club.
Boat: Participating boats should have a current, signed GYA PHRF certificate on file with GYA. Boats without a PHRF certificate will be assigned a rating based upon similar boats. The assigned rating cannot be protested. If a yacht has an ORRez Certificate she will be eligible for the ORRez trophy for 1st place in that division.

4. ENTRY FEES

Early entry – registration by September 20: \$45.00
Late entry – registration after September 27: \$55.00

There is \$5.00 discount for US Sailing membership.
CSA members in good standing half price discount.

Polo style collared shirts are available for sale at \$25.00 at registration for cash or check or can be pre-ordered with boat name. In order to have your boat name on the shirt the order needs to be placed by September 12, 2018 with order sent to Gerald Kuehler at geraldpk@outlook.com. Shirts can be picked up and paid for (cash or check) at the Friday Registration.

Competitors are urged to register early so that the Race Committee can assign accurate class breaks.

5. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Dates

Friday, September 27: NOYC

6:00-7:00 PM: Late Registration

7:00-10:00 PM:

- Crew Party at NOYC.
- Race packets will be issued,
- Race course will be declared & class breaks set.

Saturday, September 28

9:00 AM:

- First Start. 20 nm steeplechase using fixed marks. Starts will be staggered starts according to PHRF rating. The Sailing Instructions will list start times for each PHRF rating.

4:00 PM: (approximately)

- Awards presentation and Post-Race Party--following the race at NOYC, 403 N. Roadway Dr.-West End Area. Awards to be given soon after Race Committee docks.

6. REGISTRATION

Registration must be completed using the link provided at www.regattanetwork.org. Registrations will not be accepted after the conclusion of the Skippers meeting.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the CSA web site in draft form at <http://www.regattanetwork.org> and will be available in final form at the skippers meeting.

8. PENALTIES FOR BREAKING RULES OF PART 2

RRS Rule 44-720 degrees turn penalties for breaking Rules of RRS Part 2 will apply.

9. PROTESTS

Protests will be heard by the CSA Protest Committee according to the CSA Sailing Instructions at NOYC following the race. All protest forms must be properly filed with the Protest Committee within one hour of the docking of the committee boat.

10. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to First, Second, and Third Place boats in each class provided sufficient boats register. The overall fleet winner will be awarded the Wendell Gauthier Perpetual trophy. CSA members will be eligible to win the Charles Erickson Perpetual trophy (1st in Spinnaker Division) & the Nathaniel Belloni perpetual trophy (1st in Non-Spinnaker Division). CSA members must be in good standing no later than September 11, 2018.
