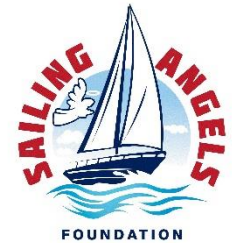

Notice of Race

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the *2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing*, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

Eligibility

This regatta is open to all boats. Three boats of similar performance will be grouped into a class; subject to the discretion of the race committee. A minimum of three boats is required to form a class. Classes which have formed by 1700 CST Monday, October 21st, 2019 will be awarded trophies as follows: One place every three boats registered by early registration deadline.

- 3 boats: 1st place
- 6 boats: 1st, 2nd place
- 9 boats: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place

Classes which form after 1700 hours Monday October 21st, 2019 (Early Registration Deadline) are eligible for trophies, but trophies may not be available for presentation at the awards ceremony.

A PHRF-GB certificate is not required for this event. The entry fee will be \$125.00. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the Early Registration Deadline (1700 hours Monday, October 21st). The deadline for all entries is Friday, November 1st, 2019 at 1700 CST; however, entries received after 1700 CST, Monday October 21st, 2019 will be subject to a \$50.00 late fee.

Competitors will receive one (1) dinner ticket and one (1) regatta shirt. Additional dinner tickets may be purchased for \$20 each and additional regatta shirts may be purchased for \$30 each. Additional dinners and shirts may be purchased at:

Competitors are encouraged to fly an American flag during the event.

Courses

The course will be a pursuit style course. Competitors will be notified of the course at the Competitor's Meeting. Courses will be in the part of Galveston Bay bounded by The Bayport Ship Channel, The Houston Ship Channel and the shoreline between Red Bluff and San Leon.

Corrected time finishes shall be calculated using US Sailing Time on Time (TOT) with A=650 & B=550
