

2019 – 2020 It Ain't Over till It's Over Mid-Winter Series (formerly Island Fever) South Beach Yacht Club San Francisco, CA Notice of Race

1. Rules

- a. This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.
- b. The Sailing Instructions will require competitors to wear personal flotation devices.

2. Eligibility and Entry

- a. The regatta is open to all boats that have a 2019 and/or 2020 Northern California PHRF certificate.
- b. Any boat without a certificate will be assigned a PHRF rating at the sole and unappealable discretion of the Race Committee.
- c. No changes will be made to PHRF after the start of the series.
- d. Eligible boats must enter and pay online at http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19849
 Only on-line entries and payments will be accepted. Deadline to register for the series without a late fee is November 12, 2019.
- e. Changes to Divisions will not be made after November 16th.
- f. One design fleets will be made at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.
- 3. Fees
 - a. Series received by November 12^{th} will be \$125.
 - b. Entries received after November 12th will be \$150.

4. Schedule of Races

- a. Dates of Racing: series consists of 5 days of racing:
 - i. 2019: 11/16, 12/21
 - ii. 2020: 1/18, 2/15, 3/21
- b. The scheduled time for the first Warning Signal is 1230 hours.
- c. Up to two (2) races may be held each day, conditions permitting.

5. Sailing Instructions.

a. The sailing instructions will be available no later than Thursday, November 14, 2019 at 1700 hours on the club website at:

6. Courses and Racing Area

- a. The races will be sailed in the San Francisco Bay, predominantly south of the Bay Bridge.
- b. Courses may use both fixed and temporary marks.
- c. Courses will be defined in the Sailing Instructions.

7. Scoring

- a. Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- b. When two to four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores with no throw-outs allowed.
- c. When five or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.
- d. Time on time correction will be used; corrected times will be calculated to the nearest second.

8. Prizes

- a. Prizes to at least the first-place winner in each division will be given after each day's racing.
- b. Prizes for first, second and third places for each division will be awarded at the end of the Series at a club-hosted reception after the last race (3/21/20).
- 9. **Disclaimer of Liability.** Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See Rule 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
