NOTICE OF RACE

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY & MANAGEMENT

The organizing authority for this Regatta is Dana Point Yacht Club (DPYC). The Dana Point Yacht Club Race Committee (RC) will manage this Regatta and shall have sole authority to apply the rules and conditions of the race, appoint a protest committee and accept or reject the entry of any boat.

2. RULES

This race shall be governed by the Rules, as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), the rules of the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF), the Equipment Requirements of US Sailing Equipment Regulations (USSER) for a near shore event and the Deed of Gift for the Dana Point Non-Spinnaker Harbor Championships. 3. ELIGIBILITY

This is an invitational regatta. To be eligible, a skipper must have won a first place trophy in a non-spinnaker/cruising class race in a non-restricted regatta that starts and finishes in the immediate Dana Point Harbor area and is sponsored by a Dana Point Harbor yacht club. Additionally, the skipper must be a member of a yacht club recognized by US Sailing, ISAF or SCYA.

4. ENTRY

Invited skippers may enter by completing a DPYC [Online Entry Form](#) and submitting it to the Race Committee at Dana Point Yacht Club by the **entry deadline of 1800 hours, Friday, October 18, 2019**. If a skipper is eligible in more than one boat, they must select one and submit their chosen entry by the entry deadline. If there are qualifying co-skippers, they may enter the Regatta as co-skippers, but one of them shall be designated as the primary helmsman on the entry form. If the Race Committee cannot verify the boat's current PHRF valid status, a copy of the boat's current PHRF Certificate will be required prior to the entry deadline. 5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be posted on the DPYC website. Any Amendments to the Sailing Instructions and further information will be provided at the skipper's meeting scheduled for 0930 Saturday, October 19, 2019

6. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Saturday, October 19, 2018
0930 - Skipper's meeting
1055 – 1st Warning Signal
Party following racing at DPYC

Sunday, October 20, 2019
1055 – 1st Warning Signal
1700 - Trophy Presentations

7. RACES SCHEDULED

Three to four races are scheduled. All races will be random leg races selected from Dana Point Race Chart v#07.1. Two races are scheduled for Saturday October 19th and 1-2 races are scheduled for October 20th. The first Warning Signal each day will be at 1055 hours. At least two races shall be sailed and scored to constitute a regatta.

8. CLASSES

There will be only one class. All boats will start together.

9. HELMSMAN

The invited qualifying skipper shall be the primary helmsman in all races. If multiple skippers qualify by winning a race in which they were entered as co-skippers, they may enter the Regatta as co-skippers but one of them shall be designated as the primary helmsman for the duration of the regatta.

10. SCORING

The Low-Point Scoring System, RRS Appendix A will apply. A boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races there shall be no throw outs. This changes RRS A2.

11. RATING SYSTEM

Boats shall be scored using PHRF Area E ratings. Any boat from outside Area E where there is no like Area E rated boat will be scored using their PHRF Base ratings. Ratings shall include PHRF non-spin offsets.

12. TROPHIES & AWARDS

The Dana Point Non-Spinnaker Championship Perpetual Trophy will be awarded to the overall winner of the Regatta. The winning skipper will be designated as this year's Dana Point Harbor Non-Spinnaker Harbor Champion and qualify to return in 2019 and defend his/her title. Daily trophies to 3rd place will be awarded for each race at the conclusion of that days racing and overalls will be awarded on Sunday October 28th at the conclusion of the regatta.

ADDITIONAL COMMENTS:

A party will follow racing on Saturday at DPYC. All skippers, their crew, club members, and guests are invited.
