ABOUT THE CAMP: Would you like to cram a season's worth of racing starts and mark rounding's into a single two day event? Want to improve your boat handling and perfect your tacks and gybes? Want to overcome your racing anxiety and get out there with your friends. Would you like to meet a group of competitive, friendly sailors from all over the US, have the chance to try different settings, trims, setups, techniques, and strategies, and learn how it affects the boat. Do you want "to become one" with your boat, to gain confidence, boat handling skills, and racing experience?

Based on the Rick White style sailing seminar, participants will experience a fun and educational racing environment through short sailing drills. On the water drills during the day are followed by video playback, critique, and discussion during the evening. Sailors will share their camp experiences, successes, failures, and techniques in a friendly and affable setting.

ELIGIBILITY: This event is open to all Hobie Waves. This is a bring your own boat event. The OA has no role or responsibility of chartering boats. Entry shall be made by completing the entry form available at https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19868. Cost is \$85.00 per boat. Entries after May 20th shall be assessed an additional charge of \$20.00. Enrollment is capped at 25 boats. This is a bring-your-own-water-bottle-event. Water fill stations will be available.

VENUE: Spray Beach Yacht Club, 23rd and Bay Blvd, Long Beach Island, New Jersey. Exit 63 on Garden State Parkway, NJ Route 72 East till end (on Long Beach Island Bay Blvd), right turn, 6 miles to 23rd street in Spray Beach, NJ, on right. This event shall be held just preceding the Hobie Wave North American Championship on June 12-14, 2020.

INSURANCE: Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$100,000 per event or the equivalent thereof. Proof of liability insurance <u>will be required</u> at the time of registration (online or in person). USCG approved PFD's are required to be correctly worn at all times while participating in the Sailing Camp.

ACCOMODATIONS: Those attendees coming to the club in RV's should park their rigs at the south end of the club grounds. Boats and trailers will be staged at the north end of the club. To help alleviate parking congestion, we kindly ask that sailors who can park their trailers outside the club along the fence to the south of the entrance. A limited number of trailers can be parked in private driveways with 2 blocks of the club – please contact Andy Keller in advance. SBYC members also welcome hosting sailors in need housing. Requests may be limited based on availability. Please let us know by May 1st of housing need to guarantee availability.
