Notice of Race

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the *Rules* as defined in the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing, the Sailing Instructions and this Notice of Race.

Eligibility

This regatta is open to all boats with valid **2019** PHRF-GB certificates, boats entering for GBCA Club Handicap, and others that can form a one design class and supply a set of class rules, subject to the discretion of the race committee. A minimum of three boats is required to form a class. Classes which have formed by 1700 hours Friday, November 29th, 2019 will be awarded trophies as follows:

- 3 boats: 1st place
- 4-5 boats: 1st, 2nd place
- 6+ boats: 1st, 2nd, 3rd place

Classes which form after 2359 hours Friday, November 29th 2019 are eligible for trophies but trophies may not be available for presentation at the awards ceremony. Additional prizes may be awarded at the discretion of Race Committee.

PHRF certificates not already submitted for a previous 2019 GBCA event may be uploaded at the time of registration (preferred), or delivered to the competitors briefing. The entry fee will be \$40.00. Current members of US Sailing will receive a \$5.00 discount. Entry fees will be refunded if the entry is withdrawn prior to the entry deadline. The deadline for all entries is Friday, December 6th, 2019 at 1930 CST, however, entries received after 2359 CST, Friday, November 29th, 2019 will be subject to a \$10.00 late fee.

Chili Entries

There will be a separate Chili Competition open to any individual or group. Entrants are requested to provide enough Chili for sampling by 10 judges. Judges will be selected by the GBCA Commodore or her delegate. Prizes will be awarded for the following: The best overall chili and the best chili submitted by a competitor who cooked onboard during the regatta. There is no entry fee for the chili competition.

Courses

Courses will be distance courses around a combination of fixed government marks and/or dropped tetrahedron marks; located in that part of Galveston Bay bounded by The Bayport Ship Channel, The Houston Ship Channel and the shoreline between Red Bluff and San Leon.

Schedule of Events

- A Competitors Briefing will be held at the GBCA office at 1900 Friday, December 6th, 2019 and by teleconference dialing (605) 313-5580 with access code 186082.
- One long or two shorter races may be run during the regatta, depending upon wind conditions. Subsequent races for each class will be started as soon as possible after the class has finished the prior race.
- The warning signal for the first race for of the regatta will not be before 1100 hours.
- Following the conclusion of Saturday's races, festivities at the GBCA clubhouse begin with chili judging (chili will be provided for the enjoyment of all attending) followed by the awards presentation beginning at approximately 6:00pm.
