

2021 SSC/RYC Delta Ditch Run

Regatta Guidelines

May 1, 2021

We are getting closer normal racing, but shore-side activities are still very limited due to the Covid pandemic. All participants must follow these guidelines. If there is a change in status, resulting in a change in these guidelines, an update will be announced and posted on the event site, <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/19906>.

Racing Guidelines: Currently San Juaquin County is in the Red Tier

County Status: Substantial / Tier 2, Red tier:

- Crewed racing is OK. Crews must wear masks at all times unless ALL crew on a boat are 2 weeks post fully completed vaccinations.
- Crew should be made up from a “social bubble” of no more than 12 people.
- Limit crew below deck to one person at a time for the duration of the sail (including pre and post-race).
- Race committee members must wear masks and practice social distancing unless ALL personnel are 2 weeks post fully completed vaccinations.

No pre or post-race activities will be held.

County Status: Moderate / Tier 3, Orange tier:

- Crewed racing is OK. Crews must wear masks at all times unless ALL crew on a boat are 2 weeks post fully completed vaccinations.
- Crews should be made up from a “social bubble” of no more than 12 people.
- Race committee members must wear masks and practice social distancing unless all personnel are 2 weeks post fully completed vaccinations.

Host yacht clubs can be open for outside bar service and/or take-out food only, and must follow the bar and restaurant guidelines of their county.

SSC & RYC COVID Club/Facility Protocols:

- Face coverings are required to be worn over your nose and mouth while you are on Richmond Yacht Club and Stockton Sailing Club grounds (this means wearing your mask everywhere but in your car and on your boat).
- Non-Richmond Yacht club member use of the RYC hoists will be from Noon, Thursday, June 10th to Noon, Friday, June 11th.
- All participants using the Stockton Sailing Club hoist must follow the directions of staging area managers and hoist operators to reduce crowding.
- Larger boats will be assigned separated slips.
- All boat trailers parked in Stockton should be placed in the City of Stockton Boat Ramp Parking across the street from Stockton Sailing Club.
- No camping will be allowed at the Richmond Yacht Club or Stockton Sailing Club.
- Portable Restrooms and Wash Stations will be set up for all participants at both RYC and SSC. Hand sanitizer will be placed at each hoist.
- Limits on Shower/Bathroom Facilities: Showers will be closed and the use of restrooms will be limited to 3- persons at a time.
- There will be no trophy presentation. Trophies will be hand delivered or mailed to you.
- DDR T-shirt sales are limited to online, and will be mailed to the address on the entry form.
