1.0. Rules:

- 1.1. Regatta will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2. Each competitor shall sail in accordance with class rules and format.

2.0. Eligibility and Entry:

- 2.1. This regatta is for one-design classes including the Laser, Weta, F18, F16, Hobie 16, Hobie Wave, A-Class Cat, 2.4mR, and Harbor 20 at this time. **Other classes will be considered on a case-by-case request.**

3.0. Registration fees for each fleet are as follows:

Circle 2 Multihull	
Single Person One Design classes	\$85.00
Double Person One Design classes	\$125.00
Discount for U.S. Sailing members	\$5.00
Additional late fee after Jan. 25, 2020 – all classes	\$25.00

Single-person one-design classes skipper receives 1 adult social ticket with registration.

Double-person one-design classes skipper receives 2 adult social ticket with registration.

Each additional adult crew member/event social ticket \$25.00

4.0. Registration and Lift Service - Times:

- 4.1. Each registration shall have a crew list and waivers of liability submitted before being considered registered.

- 4.3. The official regatta desk is located in the Recreation Building at Port Charlotte Beach Park, 4500 Harbor Blvd., Port Charlotte, FL 33952.
- 4.4. On-site registration and check-in for all classes will be available Jan. 30, 1700-1830 hrs.; Jan. 31 and Feb. 1, 0800-0915 hrs. at the Port Charlotte Beach Park official registration desk, 4500 Harbor Blvd. Port Charlotte in the Recreation Center building.
- 4.5. Lift service for registrants is offered Jan. 30, 1200 1800 hrs. and Jan. 31, 0900 1600 hrs. at Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club, 4400 Lister St., Port Charlotte, Fla., 33952. Launch times shall be posted at the Regatta Registration Desk.

6.0. Class Points Competition: For classes using this regatta in their points competition, certificates and measuring required by class rules shall be the responsibility of each class and its competitors.

7.0. Scoring:

- 7.1 The Low-Point Scoring System of Appendix A4 will be use except as modified below.
- 7.2 A minimum of one race must be completed to constitute a regatta.
- 7.3 Seven races are scheduled for Circle 1 classes racing.
- 7.4 Nine races are scheduled for Circle 2 classes racing.
- 7.5 Averaging scoring will be used for Circle 2 classes only for competitors sailing just Sat. & Sun.

8.0. Sailing Instructions: will be available during registration, at the Regatta Desk in the Recreation Center at Port Charlotte Beach Park. Sailing instructions will also be posted at the official notice boards adjacent to the Regatta Desk.

9.0. Race courses: Two circles are used for a combination of fleets. Courses will be windward-leeward, Olympic or triangle as shown in the sailing instructions. Note off-set finish lines.

- 9.1. Circle 1: Off Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club Inner Harbor East (location approximate)
Fleets: 2.4mR, and Harbor 20
- 9.2. Circle 2: Off Port Charlotte Beach Park - Middle Harbor Center (location approximate)
Fleets: Hobie 16, Hobie Wave, F16, F18, and A-Cat

10.0. Launching Locations Available:

- 10.1 Hobie 16, Hobie Wave, F18, F16, A-Class Cat - Port Charlotte Beach Park - East
- 10.2 2.4mR - Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club
- 10.3 Harbor 20 - Charlotte Harbor Yacht Club

11.0. Haul-out restriction: No haul-out restrictions
