Notice of Race

1 RULES

- 1.1 This series will be governed by the *rules* as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 USSA Sailing Prescriptions RRS 63.2 and 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.3 RS 82 will not apply.

2 ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY, DIVISIONS, and CLASSES

- 2.1 Each boat must be entered by an individual that is a member of US Sailing (USSA), a club, organization, or other association affiliated to USSA.
- 2.2 Each boat must have a valid 2020 PHRF SoCal Rating (for race 1 **ONLY**, 2019 ratings may be used).
- 2.3 For races 1, 2, 3 and 4, entries and payments must be submitted at DRYC.org no later than 1800 the day before each race. For Race 5, entry and payment must be submitted at the time of entry for Race 4 (see Race 4 Sis). Register for all 5 races before the Race 1 entry deadline and receive 5 races for the price of 4 (contact Event Chairman at rickruskin@outlook.com).
- 2.4 The entry fee for Races 1, 2, 3, and 5 is \$35 per race; Race 4 is \$45, which includes beverages and use of the BBQ grills at DRYC's Cat Harbor facility. USSA members may take a \$5 per race discount.
- 2.5 This series will have 2 divisions, PHRF (Berger) and Cruising (Stein). These divisions will be divided into classes for the series and will be posted at dryc.org by 1900, the day before Race 1.
- 2.6 Cruising Division boats may enter "non-spinnaker" by emailing the Event Chairman. One change from non-spinnaker to spinnaker configuration is allowed during this series. You must notify the Event Chairman at rickruskin@outlook.com, before the entry deadline for that race (see individual race SIs).
- 2.6 If the RC deems an entry unsuitable for the Cruising Division, it may be moved to the PHRF Division.

3 SCHEDULE and COURSES

- 3.1 The **Series Pre Race Launch Party** will be held on Friday January 3, 2020 at 1830 PM at DRYC.
- 3.2 For Cruising Division boats entered in Race 1, a **mandatory Skipper's Meeting and check in** will be held at 0900 January 4 in DRYC's lounge. No additional Skipper's Meeting will be held for this series.
- 3.3 Races 1, 2, 3 and 4 will start in the vicinity of H Mark (see Marina del Rey Course Chart 17). Race 5 will start in the vicinity of Eagle Rock, near the west end of Santa Catalina Island.
- 3.4 The scheduled time of the first warning for each race is shown in the table in NOR 3.5.
- 3.5 The following table lists the dates, scheduled warnings and approximate longest course distance for each race. Races 1 and 3 have alternate shorter courses that may be used (see Sailing Instructions)

4 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions for each race will be available at dryc.org by 1800 the Monday before the race.

5 SCORING

5.1 Each race will be scored using the course distances specified in the individual SIs for that race.

5.2 Races 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be scored using PHRF Area B RLC ratings. Race 5 will be scored using PHRF Area B OWC ratings.

5.3 A boat that came to the starting area but did not start, did not finish, retired or was disqualified shall be scored points for the finishing place one more than the number of boats that came to the starting area. A boat that did not come to the starting area shall be scored points for the finishing place two more than the number of boats that came to the starting area. This changes RRS A9.

5.4 For Division scoring purposes, all classes in a division will be combined into a single group.

6 BERTHING & MOORING

Slips at DRYC may be provided on a first-come, first-served basis. Cat Harbor moorings may be reserved for Race 4. To reserve either, email info@dryc.org at least 7 days before each race. Please include your name, contact info, boat name, OA length, draft and CF or Doc number.

7 PRIZES

7.1 See each race's SIs for information about when race trophies will be presented. Series and perpetual trophies will be presented at an awards presentation and BBQ, held at 1200 June 27, 2020.

7.2 Race and series trophies will be awarded based upon the number of entries in each class.

7.2 The PHRF Division series winner's name will be engraved on the William Berger Perpetual Trophy.

7.3 The Cruising Division series winner's name will be engraved on the William Stein Perpetual Trophy.
