2. NOTICES TO COMPETITORS

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.1 Date of Racing: Saturday July 18, 2020
- 5.2 Two races are scheduled.
- 5.3 Scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the day is 1255.

6. CLASS FLAGS

Spinnaker Pink

Non-Spinnaker Light Blue

8. THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward (L) using dropped marks for the Spinnaker classes. Non-Spinnaker classes may sail government mark courses.

9. MARKS

- **9.1** The starting and finishing marks will be a Red Ball and an Orange Flag on the signal vessel.
- **9.2** Mark 1 (windward) and Mark 2 (leeward) will be orange tetrahedrons. Replacement marks will be yellow tetrahedrons.

11. THE START

11.1 The starting line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel/RC at the starboard end and the course side of the port-end starting mark.

11.2 First start: Spinnaker (all divisions)

Second start: Non-Spinnaker

13 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between a staff displaying an orange flag on the signal vessel at the starboard end and the course side of the port-end finishing mark.

14. TIME LIMITS

14.1 Time limits are as follows:

Mark 1 45 minutes Time limit for the first boat to pass Mark 1.

Race 2.5 hours Time limit for the first boat to sail the course and finish. Finishing Window 30 minutes Time limit for boats to finish after the first boat finishes.

14.2 If no boat has passed Mark 1 within the Mark 1 time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the target time will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).

- **14.3** If no boat has sailed the course and finished within the race time limit, the race shall be abandoned. Failure to meet the time limit will not be grounds for redress. This changes RRS 62.1(a).
- **14.4** Boats failing to finish within the finishing window shall be scored Did Not Finish (DNF) without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A4, and A5.

16. SCORING

16.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series for the regatta.

21. PRIZES

The "Bev & Lloyd Stagg Perpetual Trophy" will be awarded to the Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker boats with the lowest corrected time. Prizes will be given to the first through third place finishers in Spinnaker (All Women) and (Mixed Crew), Non-spinnaker (All Women) and (Mixed Crew), as well as "The Spirit of Bikini" award.
