## 1. Rules:

The regatta will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020 (RRS), the Prescriptions of US SAILING, this Notice of Race, the Sailing Instructions, and any amendments thereto.

## 2. Eligibility and Entry:

**2.1** The regatta is open to all beach cat type Multihulls. Entrants must meet all class measurement requirements.

## **8. Courses:**

The courses will be EMSA courses, of approximately 30-40 minutes duration.

## **9. Scoring:**

**9.1** Race committee will attempt to run as many races as are practical. One or more races will constitute a regatta.

**9.2** When three or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

**9.3** When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

**9.4** Boats failing to finish within 30 minutes after the first boat sails the course and finishes will be scored Time Limit Expired (TLE) without a hearing. Boats scored TLE will be scored points equal to the number of boats finishing within the time limit plus two points by the race committee without a hearing. This changes rule A4.2, A5, and A11. 1

**10. Radio Communication:**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor received communications not available to all boats. This restriction applies to mobile phones.

**11. Trophies:**

Trophies will be awarded to the top 3 boats in each fleet.

**12. Lodging:**

**12.1** Camping is welcome on the grounds of CSC and campers are invited to use the showers and restroom facilities. The Beach House has six showers with tank-less hot water system, plenty of room for changing, and located directly beside the beach area on club grounds.

**12.2** Club Rules do not allow pets or open fires on the club grounds.

**13. Directions:**

From I-26 in either direction, take exit 102, Lake Murray Blvd. Go West on Lake Murray Blvd 3.8 miles and turn right on North Lake Road. Proceed 0.5 miles and turn left on Shuler Road (First left). CSC will be at the end of Shuler Road.
