

Notice of Race Grapevine Sailing Club Transgrape Series 2020

- 1. 1. The organizing authority is the Grapevine Sailing Club (GSC).
- 2. 2. Rules
 - a. The 2017-2020 World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of the United States Sailing Association and applicable class rules except for any of those that are altered by these Sailing Instructions, will Govern these races.
 - b. The 2020 GSC Series Race Sailing Instructions apply except as amended by this Notice of Race. The Sailing Instructions are available at grapevinesailing.org on the Racing page under documents.

 - a. Skipper's meeting 1100 at Scott's Landing Marina prior to each race.
 - b. Race dates for the Transgrape Series (Saturdays with a first warning signal at 1300):
 - i. Transgrape race 1...... 29-Feb
 - ii. Transgrape race 2....... 27-Jun
 - Transgrape race 3...... 29-Aug iii.
 - Transgrape race 4...... 24-Oct iv.
