**SUPPLEMENT to the STANDARD SAILING INSTRUCTIONS
(Numbering corresponds to the RRS Appendix S)**

[DP] denotes a rule for which the penalty is at the discretion of the protest committee.

1. RULES

- 1.2 The US Sailing Prescriptions to RRS 63.2 and RRS 63.4 will not apply.
- 1.3 US Sailing Prescription Appendix V (Alternative Penalties) will apply . The penalty shall be a 20% Scoring Penalty, calculated as stated in rule 44.3(c). This changes Appendix V2.

2. NOTICE TO COMPETITORS – Official Notice Board

- 2.3 The official notice board is located near the race office. Notices may also be published on-line at <http://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20241>

4. SIGNALS MADE ASHORE – Flagpole

- 4.3 The flagpole is located on the front lawn of the Sarasota Sailing Squadron

5. SCHEDULE OF RACES

- 5.2 Number of races:

Date	Maximum Races per day	Frist Waring Signal
Friday March 6	3	1230
Saturday March 7	4	1030
Sunday March 8	3	1030

- 5.4 On the last day of the regatta no warning signal will be made after 1400 hrs.

6. CLASS FLAGS

- 6.1 MC Scow class flag will be a "MC" on a white background.
- 6.2 Melges 14 class flag will be a "M14 insignia" on a white background.

8. MARKS

- 8.1 Windward mark (1), leeward gate marks (2s,2p), and triangle marks (1,2,3) will be will be orange inflatable inflatables.
- 8.2. Offset mark (1a) will be a small ball type mark.
- 8.3. The Starting/Finishing Mark will be a green inflatable.
- 8.4. Change Mark will be a yellow infltable.
- 8.5 In the event of the next leg change of the course, Mark 1a will not be relocated. All classes shall round the new Mark 1 leaving it to port.
- 8.6 If only one gate mark is set, boats shall leave the single mark to port.

12. TIME LIMITS

14. SCORING

- 14.1 When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 14.2 When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

15. SAFETY

- 15.1 Boats shall check in and receive acknowledgement from the race committee prior to their first race of the day. [DP]
- 15.2 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the race committee as soon as possible. [DP]

16. RADIO COMMUNICATION

- 16.1 The applicable VHF channel for this course is 11.
- 16.2 Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones except that a crew member may place or receive calls of a personal nature that do not involve the exchange of information which could affect the boat's outcome in the race. This changes RRS 41. [DP]
