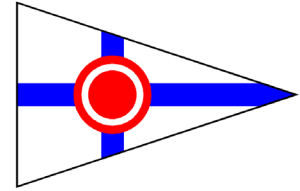




*** Notice of Race ***

Refraction Regatta

1. ORGANIZING AUTHORITY

1.1. American Legion Yacht Club (ALYC) is the organizing authority for the Refraction Regatta.

2. RULES

- 2.1. The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) as adopted by the United States Sailing Association (USSA) and the Class Rules of the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet of Southern California (PHRF), and the Notice of Race, except as altered by the Sailing Instructions.
- 2.2. The race is classified as a Category "A" Event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20
- 2.3. Boats are subject to inspection by the appropriate fleet coordinator to ensure conformity to the applicable class rules, bylaws and/or measurement certificates.
- 2.4. US Sailing Safety Equipment Requirements (USSER) apply, Category US Nearshore In addition to USSER, all boats shall carry a functioning GPS.

3. CLASSES

- 3.1. The fleet will be divided into appropriate classes based on their Base Random Leg Course (RLC) Ratings.
- 3.2. There will be a PHRF Non-Spinnaker class based on the boat's PHRF Base Random Leg Course (RLC) Rating plus its Non-Spinnaker Offset.

4. ENTRIES AND FEES

- 4.1. Online entry at US Sailing's Regatta Network website. Event 20276.
- 4.2. The entry fee is \$50.00 when received prior to 5:00pm (PDT) on the Saturday 08 August. An additional late entry fee of \$10.00 is automatically added by Regatta Network after that date and time.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 5.1. Sailing Instructions are available on the ALYC website (www.alyc.com) and on Regatta Network.
- 5.2. Any changes to the schedule of race will be posted by 7:00pm (PDT) on the day before the race on the bulletin board at the ALYC Hut, on the ALYC website and on Regatta Network.

6. SCHEDULE

- 6.1. The race is scheduled to be sailed Sunday, August 09, 2020.
- 6.2. The first warning signal for all classes is scheduled for 12:30PM (PDT).
- 6.3. One or more Random Leg races are scheduled.

7. COURSES TO BE SAILED

- 7.1. Courses will be random leg.
- 7.2. The racing area will be off Newport Beach.
- 7.3. Start and Finish Line will be located in the vicinity of the Balboa Pier.

8. SCORING

- 8.1. Scoring will be according to RRS A4.1 Low Point System.

9. INFORMATION

- 9.1. Slips, moorings and parking: ALYC Guest Dock is available for loading and unloading only. Other Moorings and transit slips are available through Newport Marina Park, (949) 270-8159. Parking is available on Balboa Blvd, Bay Ave, and along 15th St
