1. RULES

1.1. This regatta will be governed by rules as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1. Open to all PHRF boats (monohull and multihull).

2.2. PHRF Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker classes will be sailed under GYA PHRF handicapping.

2.3. To be scored in the Maxine Series, skippers must meet the eligibility requirements described in the attached "CONDITIONS FOR THE PENSACOLA BAY MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES".

2.4. PHRF entries must have a valid PHRF Rating Certificate or accept a temporary, provisional rating assigned by the Race Committee.

1030: Signal Vessel will depart PYC Dock; Will broadcast all necessary instructions on the water per Pensacola Bay General SI's 3.2.

1155: Warning Signal for the First Race.

*5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1. The Sailing Instructions will consist of the current Pensacola Bay Sailing Instructions, and supplementary Sailing Instructions that will be posted on the official notice board located on the deck of the Watson Sailing Center.

5.2. The Pensacola Bay Sailing Instructions are available online and at race day registration. Supplementary instructions may be posted during the Competitors Meeting or posted earlier online. Attendance is recommended.

6. COURSES

6.1. The courses may include triangle and/or windward/leeward with dropped marks (See the SSI's for details.).

7. SCORING

7.1. The Low Point Scoring System, Appendix A2 (RRS), will apply for this Maxine #3 Regatta.
7.2. See the separate Notice of Series for scoring information for the Maxine Sansom Memorial Trophy Series, the PYC Championship Series, and the Pensacola Bay Championship Series.

8. AWARDS

8.1. Trophy Presentations for this Maxine #3 Regatta will be at PYC after the scoring is final.

*9. FURTHER INFORMATION

9.1. In response to the COVID-19 Pandemic the following actions are necessary:

9.11 Only on-line registrations accepted NLT May 22.

9.12 No competitors briefing will be held; all instructions will be broadcast on the water.

9.13 All skippers participating in the race shall ensure that each member of their crew has been

properly screened for COVID-19 symptoms prior to being admitted to the PYC facilities before and after the race.

9.14 Trophies will be awarded after the race on the patio (not in the clubhouse). Social Distancing required.

CONDITIONS FOR THE PENSACOLA BAY MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES

1) The <u>MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY</u> will be awarded for participation and performance on Pensacola Bay. The perpetual trophy will be held in trust at the Pensacola Yacht Club, engraved with the name of the winning yacht from each fleet. The individual yachts will receive personal trophies to commemorate their performance.

2) Races are to be sailed under the management of the race committee sponsoring each event. The series will be governed by the current international Yacht Racing Rules, the current prescriptions of USSA, and by the sailing instructions in force for each race for that race.

3) Each of the participating yacht clubs (PBYC, NYC, and PYC) will designate one race, open to other yacht club members to be hosted by that club during the year, to be scored for the yachts participating in the series. The designated races shall be selected and published prior to February first of each year. Should a race be canceled, a new race at that club will designated as counting towards points for the series.

4) Skippers must be members in good standing of one of the participating yacht clubs for eligibility and scoring for the series. Since the series is to determine the winning yacht, different skippers may race the yacht for the series as long as they are eligible according to the requirements of the prior sentence. However, once a yacht is entered into the series, the skipper at that time will not be eligible to skipper another yacht for entry into or scoring for, the series. Entry into the <u>MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES</u> will be automatic upon entry into any of the individual designated races and the above eligibility requirements are met.

5) There will be two overall fleets in the series: Spinnaker and Non-Spinnaker. Yacht may not enter the series in more that one fleet. The series scoring shall be in accordance to USSA Appendix A-Scoring. Rule A2 is modified so as no score is excluded. The individual yacht clubs shall provide the next club hosting a <u>MAXINE SANSOM MEMORIAL TROPHY SERIES</u> race the official scoring results from that club's race, prior to the next race for the series. The official scoring should note those yachts not eligible for the series. The overall winning yacht for the series in each fleet will be determined after the results of the last race of the series, and shall be awarded trophies as described above.
