

AYC Sailing Center and Marina Guidelines

Waterfront Staff will monitor all 3 marinas and the SC grounds throughout the day to continue to engage with members while ensuring suggested guidelines are being upheld.

- On AYC property including marinas, launch areas and parking lots members should continue to follow suggested social distancing & PPE guidelines.
- Masks must be worn when coming within 6' of AYC staff.

Facilities: Member Access to Sailing Center

- Sailing Center Locker Rooms are available 24/7 with an AYC Member access card paper towel dispensers have been installed outside of the locker rooms to use when touching the exterior door handles prior to entry. Face coverings must be used inside of AYC buildings.
- Administrative Offices at the Sailing Center will remain closed until further notice.
- Junior Fleet Opti Shed will remain locked Junior Fleet staff are available 9am-5pm M-F to grant access.

Guidelines: Sailing Center and Marinas

- Per State Guidelines effective at 1700 on May 15, 2020 no more than 10 people on a boat including Captain and crew. Vessel and boat races are authorized so long as no more than 10 people are in a gathering at one time.
- Members should avoid congregating and maintain 6-foot social distancing
- Handwashing stations will be set up at the Annex and Sailing Center for member & guest use.
- No rafting up to keep distance between boaters.
- Pump out should be done with wearing a mask and gloves. All surfaces will be sanitized after each use. (Please contact the Dockmasters office if you plan on using the pump out station on E dock so we may sanitize after usage).
- Once in the water, members should head off the dock as soon as possible to keep the flow of operation smooth and limit the number of members & their guests. gathered in one area.
- Members who dry sail should keep staff hours in mind to ensure they return to dock in a timely manner if they wish to be hauled that day.
- Initially two hoists will be made available for members, the 3-ton hoist near 5th street and a 2-ton hoist. This will allow staff to manage the number of boats being launched and limit the number of staff/members operating hoists while allowing for the controls/lines to be disinfected on a regular basis.
