### 1. RULES

This regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the “*The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017 – 2020*”

### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. Eligible boats and drivers may enter by completing an online entry form available through the Regatta Network at <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20443> Additional help will also be given out at the Beginning Race Start Seminar held at PMYC <http://pmyc.org/> on Tuesday, April 14 at 1900 hours (7 PM).
- 2.2. Two classes, **PHRF** and **Cruising**. **Novice** boats (eligible for the Perpetual Trophy) are defined as those boats where the skipper’s experience is two races max.
- 2.3. **Boat Owners may skipper during the start** but must hand off the helm to the Novice skipper within three minutes for the Novice skipper to be eligible for the Homeport Perpetual Trophy.
- 2.4. Boats without a rating will be assigned one by the PRO based on the PHRF SoCal’s ratings for similar makes & models of boats. PRO may combine classes as needed.
- 2.5. Yacht club membership is not required for skippers of “novice boats.”
- 2.6. The entry fee is FREE for all boats. Completed entry forms will be accepted by 0930 HRS on Sat, April 18, 2020.



### 3. SCHEDULE OF RACES

3.1 The schedule time for the warning signal for the first race is 11:55 AM

3.2 The R/C will run one (1) race such as to finish by 1600 hours at the latest.

### 4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS / SKIPPERS MEETING

4.1 The Sailing Instructions and classes will be posted on <https://www.regattanetwork.com/event/20443> by 1900 hours April 17, 2020.

4.2 Sailing instructions will also be available at the Skipper Meeting at PMYC on Saturday, April 18, at 0900 hours.

### 5. COURSES / SCORING

5.1 Courses will be Random Leg using ASMBYC Marina Del Rey Course Chart 17. If marks are missing, the use of an inflatable orange or yellow mark may be used.

5.2 The starting area will be in the vicinity of SS Mark.

### 6. HOSPITALITY

### 7. TROPHIES

Trophies will be presented by ASMBYC to the winners of their respective divisions. The Homeport Perpetual trophy will be awarded to the winners of the novice PHRF and Cruising class or the winning skipper who qualifies as a "Novice" if classes are combined.
