Please note there will be NO onsite registration for this event. Competitors will not need to check in onshore prior to this event, so please make sure that you register online with your correct sail number, email address. #### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 RRS A2.1 is changed so that there will be no throw out.
- 1.3 RRS 44.1 is changed so that Appendix "V" (Alternative Penalties) Rules V1 and V2 will be in effect.
