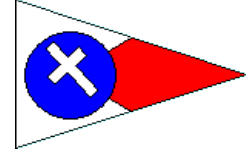

NOTICE OF RACE

1. Rules

1.1. The series will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. Eligibility and Entry

2.1. This series is open to all boats holding a valid Monterey Bay PHRF certificate. Any boat not holding the current Monterey Bay PHRF certificate may petition the Race Committee for entry and the committee may assign a rating and start time based on ratings of similar boats. There will be the following PHRF divisions: A fleet (77 or less), B Fleet (greater than 78), a Double Handed division, Jib & Main (181 or less), and Jib & Main (greater than 181). The Race Committee reserves the right to change the PHRF divisions based on the number of boats that register.

2.2. PHRF divisions shall have a minimum of two persons onboard.

2.3. Double Handed division shall have exactly two persons board.

2.4. Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form at <http://club.scyc.org/racing/>.

3. Fees

3.1. The entry fee is \$50.00 and is applicable if entry is completed by 2000 hours on June 11, 2020.

3.2. The late entry fee of \$70.00 is applied to all entries received after 2000 hours on June 11, 2020.

3.3. Registration closes at 1100 hours on June 14, 2020.

4. Schedules

4.1. A Competitors' Briefing is scheduled for 1030 hours on June 14, 2020 at the SCYC clubhouse.

4.2. The scheduled time of the first warning signal is 1225 hours.

4.3. One race will be scheduled.

4.4. An awards ceremony will be held after racing at the SCYC clubhouse.

5. Sailing Instructions

5.1. The sailing instructions will be available at the Competitors' Briefing, and online at the event link listed above

6. Venue, Courses

6.1. Racing will be around temporary inflatable buoys or fixed buoys in the area bounded by Moss Landing to the southeast, Davenport to the northwest and extending up to five miles off shore.

6.2. The race will be a pursuit race with boats starting at a time determined by their handicap from the largest handicap starting first to the smallest.

6.3. The start time of each boat will be available at the Competitors' Briefing.

7. Scoring

7.1. One race is required to complete the championship.

7.2. No score will be excluded.

8. Prizes

8.1. Prizes will be awarded to each division for first place and additional places based upon the number of entries at the discretion of the organizing authority.

9. Course

9.1. The course will appear in the sailing instructions.
