

NOTICE OF RACE

1. INVITATION

- 1.1. The Corpus Christi Yacht Club (CCYC) would like to cordially invite you to attend the 2020 Surfin' Safari scheduled for June 13-14, 2020.
- 1.2. The following one-design classes are invited to participate in this regatta: J/24, J/22, and J/105. Other classes are invited to form as well. Please contact the Race Chair about forming a class not listed above. A minimum of three boats will need to be present in order for a class to remain eligible.

2. HOST CLUB

- 2.1. CCYC is a private yacht club, located on Corpus Christi Bay at 98 Coopers Alley, Corpus Christi, TX 78401 (361-883-6518), near downtown. Additional information on CCYC is available at <u>http://www.ccyc.com</u>. Please note that pets are not allowed on club property.
- 2.2. We are proud to announce that we have joined the race to restore ocean health with Sailors for the Sea's Clean Regattas program. Protecting our local waters is very important to this regatta and we ask for your help in this effort. To learn more about this initiative visit www.sailorsforthesea.org.

We ask for your help on the following items:

- Ensuring your recycling and trash are separated before disposing of waste
- Switch your team over to reusable water bottles and cups
- 2.3 CCYC will follow applicable Covid regulations with respect to running the regatta, which may include the skippers' meeting, social, and other gathering situations. The social may or may not happen, depending on restrictions in place at the time of the regatta. However, the club is looking into alternative ways to have a gathering while still observing currents regulations and safeguarding health. We will attempt to run a normal regatta in as many aspects as possible, and there will be no attempt to enforce social distancing on personal yachts. This will be left to individual crews to manage as they see fit. The decision to participate and race will be at the discretion of the skippers/crews of the individual boats. See RRS Part 1—Rule 4—"Decision to Race".
- 2.4 Corpus Christi Yacht Club is a private facility, with limited capacity at this time due to Covid19 restrictions. Therefore, use of the facility's dining room

areas is unavailable at this time, so please avoid use of the club facilities during the regatta. Reservations for dining may be made with the club in advance if desired. Restroom facilities outside at the pool area may be used if necessary. Thank you for your help in following these requirements.

3. RULES

- 3.1. The regatta will be governed by the 2017-2020 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the associated prescriptions of the U.S. Sailing Association, the rules applicable to each class, this Notice, and the official Sailing Instructions for the 2020 Surfin' Safari.
- 3.2. Any rules specific to a particular class are specified in an addendum to this notice. Where there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and any addendum, the addendum shall govern.

4. REGISTRATION

- 4.1. *Registration Fee*
 - 4.1.1. The registration fee for this regatta is \$105.00 for each boat. Registration ends on Friday, June 12, 2020 at 5:00PM. Registration includes slip fee and trailer storage in Corpus Christi marina for Friday and Saturday nights.
- 4.2. *Late Registration Fee*
 - 4.2.1. There will be no late registration fee due to uncertainties caused by the current Covid issue.
- 4.3. US Sailing Discount4.3.1. US Sailing members may take a \$5.00 discount off their registration fee.
- 4.4. All boats are encouraged to register early at: <u>https://www.regattanetwork.com/clubmgmt/applet_registration_form.php?reg</u> <u>atta_id=20756</u>
- 4.5. Boats will be required to register on-line.
- 4.6. The Registration Fee includes participation in the regatta, use of mast hoists for mast stepping, use of motorized hoist (ramps are also available) to launch and retrieve boats, trailer storage/boat dockage for the duration of the regatta, food and beer after the races on Saturday and snacks and beverage as part of Sunday's award presentation.
- 4.7. The Registration Fee does <u>NOT</u> include access to dock keys needed to open gates to the piers in the Marina. Any boat wanting a gate key to the piers on the L-head must visit the Corpus Christi Marina Office and provide a deposit.
- 4.8. The Registration Fee does <u>NOT</u> include trailer storage or slip fees prior to the Friday of the regatta or after the Sunday of the regatta. Those arrangements must be made with the Corpus Christi Marina Office.

5. COURSES

5.1. Races will be sailed on windward-leeward courses or variations thereof.

5.2. All races will be conducted in Corpus Christi Bay.

6. SCORING

6.1. No race scores will be excluded from a boat's regatta score, this modifies rule A2. The scoring penalty as provided by RRS 44.3 of the RRS will apply.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

7.1. Sailing Instructions will be distributed to entrants at registration.

8. AWARDS

8.1. Awards will be presented to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place boats of each class, depending on class participation.

9. INSPECTION & MEASUREMENT

9.1. All official participants are subject to inspection and measurement at any time during the regatta if required by class rules.

10. TRAILER/BOAT STORAGE

- 10.1. Trailer parking tags must be displayed on your trailer at all times while trailers are parked in the Corpus Christi Marina or the City Marina Staff will impound your trailer and may issue a fine. The trailer parking tag fee is included as part of your registration fee, but you must pick up the tag during registration and put it on your trailer.
- 10.2. Boats will be assigned a specific slip at registration. All slips are owned by the City and the ones assigned for use during this regatta are going to be marked by City Marina Staff. Any deviation from these slip assignments will incur an extra charge that will be your responsibility. Slip fees for your assigned slip are included in your registration fee.
- 10.3. If you wish to store your boat/trailer on the waterfront before the Friday of the regatta or after the Sunday of the regatta, you MUST make prior arrangements with the City Marina office at 361-826-3980 (note there will be separate storage/slip/trailer fees associated with such).
- 10.4. The information for each registered boat and skipper will be provided to the Corpus Christi Marina Office in the event there are any problems.

11. LAUNCHING/RETRIEVING BOATS

11.1. A fixed motorized crane will be available for boat launching during registration/check-in times (see Regatta Schedule), to arrange for crane access outside these times contact Doug Weakly at <u>doug.weakly@yahoo.com</u>, Josh Richline at <u>jrichline@Richline.cc</u>. or Tony Hauglum at <u>thauglum@swbell.net</u>. Note that a fixed mast stepping crane is available. Regatta participants will be responsible for setting up, launching and retrieving their own boats.

12. LIABILITY

12.1. Registering for and entering the Regatta shall in no way hold Corpus Christi Yacht Club, its officers, committee persons, and/or any sponsoring group liable for injury to participants, crew, or yachts, nor any complications which may arise from the Covid19 virus. All participants in this regatta must sign the regatta waiver online or at CCYC front desk prior to regatta. Any boat without full compliance with this requirement will not be considered registered or scored in the regatta.

13. REGATTA SCHEDULE

- 13.1. Friday, June 12, 2020
 - 13.1.1. 1800-2000 hrs: Initial check-in, Registration and Early Launching
- 13.2. <u>Saturday, June 13, 2020</u>
 - 13.2.1. 0800-0900 hrs: Final check-in, Registration and Launching
 - 13.2.2. 0915 hrs: Skipper's Meeting
 - 13.2.3. 1030 hrs: First race signal of the day, additional races to follow
 - 13.2.4. After completion of racing, "social distancing" dock social
- 13.3. Sunday, June 14, 2020
 - 13.3.1. 0930 hrs: First race signal of the day, additional races to follow (no races will start after 1330 hrs)
 - 13.3.2. After Races: Awards (format TBD), subject to any protest hearings that may be heard

14. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- 14.1. All Piers, L-Head and T-Heads are considered Public Parks and are run and patrolled by the City of Corpus Christi. No open containers are allowed in the city's Public Parks.

15. TRACKING

15.1. Unless otherwise prohibited by class rules voluntary tracking of boats will be provided using RaceQs. This is not a requirement, but rather a service for fleet building and training. Tracking will be viewable at the following link. http://raceqs.com/regattas/75292. No registration is required. However, 1 crewmember per boat will need to download the app and record and upload the race data each day.

ADDENDUM TO NOTICE OF RACE J/22 CLASS ONLY

- The same crew and same three class sails must be used during the entire Regatta. Substitutions can only be made with the written approval of the Principal Race Officer or Chief Judge.
- Class Rules 2.8 (eligibility, aka class membership], 2.9 (measurement certificate) and 8.9 (weight limit) of the IJ22CA Class Rules will not apply for eligibility to participate in this Regatta.

Note: Basically, this means that the class membership requirement, boat measurement requirement and the crew weight limitation **do not apply** for eligibility to participate in this Circuit Regatta and will not affect scoring nor prizes/awards in this Regatta. However, Boats lacking a measurement certificate or whose helmsperson does not meet the class membership requirement will suffer a scoring penalty for the 2020 J22 Southwest Circuit, see Notice of Circuit on the J/22 Southwest District website www.j22southwest.org

- Races will be sailed on windward/leeward courses or variations thereof. Offset weather marks and leeward gates may be used.
- No race scores will be excluded from a boat's regatta score. This modifies RRS A2. The scoring penalty as provided by RRS 44.3 and as modified by the sailing instructions will apply.
- Inspection & Measurement
- All participants are subject to inspection and measurement at any time during the Regatta. The Race Committee may, at its discretion, inspect any yacht in order to confirm compliance with the prescribed class rules concerning construction and measurements, safety rules when racing, crew prohibition and restrictions when racing. Class royalty tags must be present on all sails.
- Disclaimer of Liability
- Competitors participate in this individual Circuit Regatta and the 2020 J/22 Southwest Circuit entirely at their own risk. See RRS rule 4, *Decision to Race*. The Organizing Authority, Hosts, IJ22CA, District 5 and its officers will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after a Regatta.
- Bow Numbers
- To facilitate scoring and the identification of boats for the purpose of RRS 29.1, 29.2, 30.1, 30.2, 30.3 and 30.4, unique TWO (2) digit bow numbers are required to be fixed to both external port and starboard sides of the forward bow area of each competing boat hull. These numbers must be affixed to both port and starboard as follows:
- a. The leading edge of the forward number shall be 250mm/10" aft of the stem.
- b. The leading edge of the aft numbers shall be 100mm/4" aft of the aft edge of the forward number.

- c. The top edge of both numbers shall be 100mm/4" from the rail.
- d. All numbers must contrast with the color of the hull and be at least 305mm/12" in height.
- Bow numbers will be assigned to each participating crew for the duration of the 2020 J/22 Southwest Circuit. Bow numbers 01 through 10 are pre-assigned respectively to the top ten competitors of the 2017 J/22 Southwest Circuit.

Reserved Bow Numbers

- Bow numbers 11 through 99 will be assigned out of the then open pool of unassigned numbers by the District Governor for new Circuit participants. Issues relating to bow numbers (e.g. assignment, placement, size, etc.) will be resolved solely by the USJ22CA District 5 Governor of record.
- It shall be the responsibility of each participating competitor to obtain and affix the assigned bow numbers to their yacht. The Fleets, host Yacht Clubs and the Southwest District are not responsible to provide numerals for bow numbers.

ADDENDUM TO NOTICE OF RACE J/105 CLASS ONLY

The Notice of Race for the J/105 Class shall be amended as follows. Where there is conflict between the Notice of Race and this Addendum, this Addendum shall govern.

16. RULES

- 16.1. This Regatta will be governed by Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2017- 2020, the 2020 J/105 Class Association Rules (J105CAR), the Notice of Race with this Addendum for the J/105 Class, and the Sailing Instructions for the regatta.
- 16.2. J105CAR Rule 3.1 (owner membership) will not apply for eligibility to participate in this event. Rules 3.1 through 3.13 are modified to the extent not to require that the owner-driver be a current Class member.
- 16.3. J105CAR Rule 7.1 (crew weight limit) will not apply. The crew shall consist of a maximum of six (6) persons, including the skipper.

2. LAUNCHING/RETRIEVING BOATS

2.1 Section 11.1 is modified to note that the fixed motorized crane referenced is limited to 3 tons and will <u>not</u> be available for J/105 boat launching. J/105 participants requiring launch/retrieval service should contact the City Marina

Office at 361-826-3980 to make arrangements for use of the travelling hoist or a crane service. Use of the travelling hoist is Monday-Friday only with a 48-hour advance reservation required.

3. HAUL- OUT RESTRICTIONS

3.1 Except in an emergency, boats shall not be hauled out during the regatta except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee.

3.2 All boats shall be in the water by 8:00 p.m. on Friday, June 12, 2020, and shall remain in the water through the end of the regatta, subject to the provisions of 3.1.

4. RADIO COMMUNICATION

4.1 Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to any sailing related communications on mobile telephones.

5. AWARDS

5.1 Section 8.1. of the Notice of Regatta is revised to limit awards to the 1st and possibly 2nd place finishers, depending on participation.
