

Davis Island Snipe Fleet #96 Snipe Summer Series (June - October) Notice of Race

1. Rules

The Regatta is organized under the authority of Snipe Fleet 96 and Davis Island Yacht Club. This regatta will be governed by rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing including Appendix V.

2. Eligibility

The regatta is open to all boats of the Snipe class, as defined by SCIRA.

3. Entry and Fees

Boats may enter prior to the competitor's meeting by completing the online registration and paying the entry fee. Early registration is highly encouraged. Entry Fee: \$30.00 + tax

4. Schedule

First Saturdays of each month (June 6, July 4, August 1, Sept 5, Oct 3)

- 1000-1045 Registration
- 1100 Competitors' Meeting
- 1200 First warning signal. There will be no warning signals made after dark.
 - Times will be adjusted for wind... it is summer in Florida

5. Measurement

All boats are subject to random inspection or measurement by the Organizing Authority at any time during the regatta for rules compliance.

6. Sailing Instructions

The Sailing Instructions will be available at registration and online at divc.org.

7. Venue

Racing will be held on Hillsborough Bay south of the DIYC Clubhouse.

8. Courses

The courses will be Windward/Leeward courses with drop marks per the Sailing Instructions.

9. Penalty System

The alternative penalties of Appendix V will be used.

10. Scoring

10.1 When fewer than five races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

10.2 When five or more races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10.3 For the daily prizes all race scores will count.

11. Prizes

There will be a prize for each race for the top finisher and for the top three finishers after the series has been completed, and handed out individually.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in these regattas entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The Organizing Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, sickness, disease or death, sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regattas. By participating in this event, each competitor agrees to release the race organizers from any and all liability associated with such competitor's participation in these events to the fullest extent permitted by law.

13. Logistical Support

Boats may arrive Friday afternoon or Saturday morning, and are expected to depart by Saturday evening.

Note also that there is currently no credit card sales availability for food or drink, and the Club does not take cash at all. Any purchases would need to be charged to a member.
