Greetings Junior Families-

FBYC is very excited to host the first 2020 Junior Event on the Chesapeake Bay and we welcome our racers and their families. We will be adhering to all safety measures to ensure a great and healthy regatta.

We have had a few inquiries regarding camping in tents on our lovely grounds. FBYC welcomes our sailor campers but wants to share that currently we have limited camping space (tents only). Currently, under Governor Executive Orders, Phase 2, all tents must be 20' apart. Subsequently, our ability to provide our typical tenting space is severely limited.

Anyone wishing to camp in a tent must be already registered for the Jr Regatta and MUST reach out to our General Manager, Brian Ankrom to inquire of space and availability. Additionally, you will need to check in with Mr. Ankrom upon arrival for your tent space as spaces will be determined by total space, reservations and tent size. Mr. Ankrom will be managing the list of campers. We appreciate your understanding and adherence to our state requirements as well as FBYC safety needs.
