

NOTICE OF RACE AMENDMENT 2 (24 June 2020)

# Sunset Fun Sail Series

The following amendments to the Notice of Race publish on 2 June 2020 will be in effect as of 24 July 2020:

### 5. **BOATS**

5.1 The regatta will be sailed in One Design boats (Shields and Santana 22), and PHRF rated boats based on valid PHRF certificates issued by the Monterey Bay PHRF Committee.

#### 6. SCHEDULE

6.1. The Sunset Fun Sail Series will be sailed on every Wednesday evening as of June 10, 2020 until further notice.

6.2 Participating boats shall check in with the race committee on VHF Channel 68 by no later than 17:45 on the day of the event. Failure to check in may result in a no score.

### 7. COURSES

7.1 The starting area will be in the vicinity of the MPYC "G" buoy.

7.2 Courses will be announced by the race committee on VHF Channel 68 or posted on the race committee boat.

### 8. THE START AND FINISH

8.1 Each race will be started in accordance with RRS 26 with a warning signal given 5 minutes before the starting signal. The scheduled time for the First Warning is 17:55 or as close to the time as possible.

8.2 One Design boats will have a separate start provided 5 or more Shields and Santanas check in with the race committee no later than 17:45 on the day of each race.

8.3 In the absence of a race committee, races will start by using the MPYC rabbit start procedure available at <u>www.mpyc.org</u> under Race documents. The fleet captains and Race Chair will coordinate the rabbit boats for the respective fleets.

8.4 The finish line will be the imaginary line between MPYC "F" and the flagpole on the MPYC clubhouse roof.

# 9. SCORING

9.1 The 2020 MPYC Sailing Instructions (section 13) will apply.

# 10. **PENALTIES**

11.1 RRS Appendix V1 and V2 will apply.

11.2 While participating boats shall adhere to RRS, no protests will be accepted. Skippers and crew of boats involved in possible rules altercations and or contact between boats, shall resolve their differences between themselves. MPYC bears no responsibility for any bruised egos, limbs or boats.

# 11. SAFETY REGULATIONS

11.3 All competing boats shall comply with relevant social distancing requirements, and all skippers and crew shall wear face masks in accordance with California and Monterey county requirements.

11.6 In the event of using a rabbit start, the designated rabbit boat shall be considered as a committee boat for purposes of the race, the rabbit boat should be treated as a mark. With this in mind, no competing boats may interfere with the rabbit boat until she has completed her tack to starboard at the end of the start period.

11.7 If any boat makes contact with, or interferes with the rabbit boat, such boat will be disqualified and must retire. Should the rabbit boat need to abandon the start, she shall sound two horns signally all boats to abandon the race. All boats shall keep clear of the rabbit boat to allow her to restart the race.

11.8 A boat that retires from a race shall notify the rabbit boat and or the Race Chair as soon as reasonably possible.
