

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the *Racing Rules of Sailing*. Changes in sailing instructions shall be made in writing before a race by posting in proper time on the official notice board. The official notice board is outside the CBYC clubhouse.

CLASSES: One design, PHRF spinnaker and non-spinnaker with three or more entries. The PHRF class split will be displayed on the Race Committee boat prior to the first warning signal. Yachts wishing to race non-spinnaker shall use the non-spinnaker rating printed on their PHRF certificate and shall put that rating on their entry card. All other yachts are to use their PHRF buoy rating. The Race committee upon request will assign yachts without a PHRF certificate a rating. Non-spinnaker class; only one headsail shall be used at a time.

ELIGIBILITY: This regatta is open to all sailors.

ENTRIES & FEES: All entries for series 1 will be online with Regatta Network. No entry fee, but must enter each series, (a new entry must be filed for each series). Once entered in a series a yacht must finish the series at that same rating and in the same class in which it started. See web address below.

RACE SCHEDULE: This event will be comprised of Fourteen races divided into three series as follows:

The warning signal will be at 1800 hours, with the first start at 1805 hours. The starting order will be displayed on the Race Committee boat prior to the star of the first race.

COURSES & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS: The courses for these races will be selected from the CBYC Course Chart/Sailing Instruction 2019 and any posted supplements. Start/Finish area #1 will be used. The CBYC Course Chart/Sailing Instruction 2019 is available at the CBYC clubhouse and web site. The race committee will attempt to communicate instructions over channel 72.

LAUNCHING: A hoist of up to 6,000 pounds and a dinghy ramp are available at the CBYC dry storage facility located along Via Cabrillo Marina, west of the CBYC clubhouse. Guest parking is limited to the area south of dry storage, street and public lot across 22^{nd} St.

TROPHIES: There will be daily trophies. Series trophies will be presented at the CBYC annual awards presentation November 7, 2020.

ACTIVITIES: All participants shall comply with the latest COVID-19 Social Distancing requirements of the State, County, City and CBYC. All sailors and crew should use member/skipper keycards to enter a rear of club to access the downstairs restrooms (no entrance to Club's upstairs restrooms through front doors). If skippers plan to go or to invite their crew to visit the CBYC bar and dining room, following the race, reservations should be made by calling the club: 310.519.1694. Please note that the club computers and staff will not be available for sailors to register or pay.
